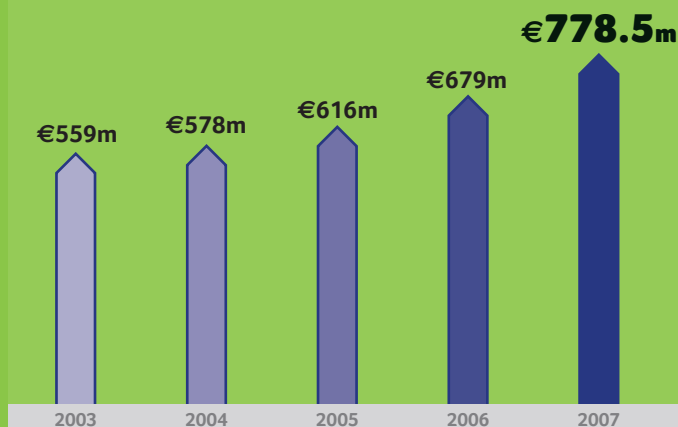

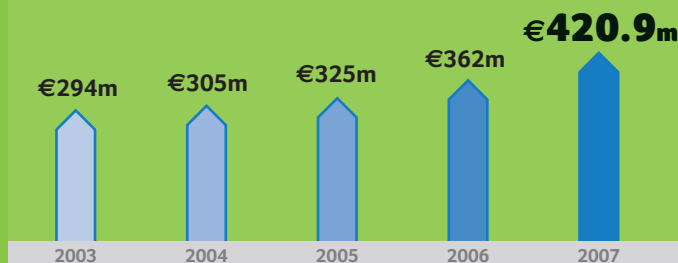

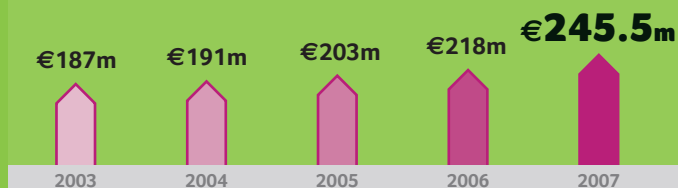

Lotto Games

The Lotto Games category grew significantly during 2007 and finished the year up 29.5% to €468.7 million.

In the core Lotto game, Lotto sales increased by 40.2% to €357.7 million. This was the largest ever growth in the Lotto game. Lotto Plus also performed very well with a 4.7% increase in sales to €100.1 million.

Sales of Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 amounted to nearly €11 million. With a prize payout level of 66%, Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 continues to provide an attractive option for players who prefer higher odds of winning. In 2007, those players shared €7.2 million in prizes.

EuroMillions sales in Ireland in 2007 were €118.7 million. The highest jackpot roll was €75 million. There was added excitement with two Super Draws in 2007 - one in February, when €100 million was guaranteed, and one in September when €130 million was guaranteed.

The EuroMillions Plus game, launched in June 2007, generated sales of €16.4 million, bringing the overall sales of EuroMillions related games to €135.2 million for 2007.

The ever-popular TellyBingo game continued in its twice weekly lunchtime TV slot on RTE One. It generated sales of €13.7 million and provided great entertainment value for viewers. Players shared €9.9 million in prizes during 2007, a 72% prize payout level. In all there were over 1.2 million TellyBingo prize winners, including 24 Snowball winners, the largest of which was Pauline McDonnell from Foxford, Co. Mayo who won €65,000 in June.

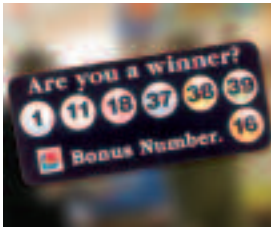

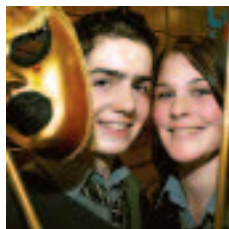

Chairman's Statement

Ráiteas an Chathaoirligh



In 2007, we celebrated the National Lottery's 20th anniversary with a very successful business performance. Sales growth for the year was an impressive 14.6%, achieving an unprecedented sales level of €778.5 million, up from €679.1 million in 2006. This generated the highest ever amount of funds for good causes in the history of the company.

The success of the National Lottery in 2007 demonstrates the ability of the organisation to effectively develop the structure and range of its games to optimise player participation levels and maximise returns to the Irish community.

2007 was a particularly good year for our players with an increase of 16.2% in prizes won as they shared in the fun and excitement of increased prizes across National Lottery games. This was particularly apparent in the Lotto game where we had the highest rollover in eleven years culminating in a record jackpot win of over €16 million.

Apart from the lucky winners of National Lottery games, the other real winners are, of course, the good causes which benefit directly from the success of the National Lottery. During the year, €245.5 million was raised for distribution by Government to beneficiaries throughout Ireland. This represents an increase of 12.9% from €217.5 million in the previous year. Over the twenty years since the National Lottery was launched, the cumulative amount of money raised for Irish good causes now stands at a very impressive €2.85 billion. This level of funding has made a significant difference to communities, projects and individuals in the areas of Youth, Sports, Recreation & Amenities; Health & Welfare; Arts, Culture & National Heritage and the Irish Language.

During 2007, our draw games – Lotto and EuroMillions – accounted for 77.6%, or €603.9 million, of sales – an increase of €96.6 million compared to the previous year. Within this category, undoubtedly the star performer was the Lotto game. Driven by as many as seven jackpots over €5 million, and the exciting record €16 million jackpot win by the Cunningham family in Cork, Lotto sales were up an exceptional 40.2% to €357.7 million. This is by far the best performance ever by the Lotto game and demonstrates the suitability of the 6/45 game format, introduced in November 2006, for our player base.

Following a roll of exceptionally large jackpots in 2006, the EuroMillions jackpots in the year under review tended to be somewhat lower. The successful launch of EuroMillions Plus mid year contributed to overall EuroMillions sales for 2007 of €135.2 million, compared to €145.3 million in 2006.

Our scratchcard business was also successful during 2007, achieving record sales of €160.9 million, up 2.2% from €157.4 million in 2006. This performance was driven by the strategy of having multiple games of different styles on offer to players at any one time and the continuing popularity of our TV game shows.

Throughout the year, a considerable amount of work was undertaken on the development of games for internet and mobile phones, to ensure that our control procedures are robust before proceeding to a player launch.

During 2007, a record €420.9 million was won by players in prizes across all our games, with an overall prize payout rate of 54.1% of sales. On average, the National Lottery paid out over €8 million to winners each week in 2007.

I am delighted to report that the increased level of sales and activity across the business was achieved with a reduction in our total operating costs as a percentage of sales. Our 3,623 agents shared €48.4 million in commissions and bonuses and other costs of sales were €42.0 million reflecting the increased level of sales. Administration costs for the year amounted to €18.7 million and were reduced to 2.4% of sales.

I would like to thank our employees and agents for their hard work and commitment to growing the business during 2007.

I would also like to thank our regulator, Tánaiste and Minister for Finance, Brian Cowen, TD, and his department for their ongoing support during the year. Together with our other shareholder, An Post, they continue to provide guidance and counsel to the board and management team.

2007 was my first full year as Chairman of An Post National Lottery Company and my job was certainly made easier by the calibre and contribution of my board colleagues and the National Lottery management team, to whom I would like to pay a particular tribute.

As we face into 2008, we will continue to focus on delivering our vision of providing exciting and engaging lottery games that bring fun and entertainment to everyone.

In doing so, we are committed to operating the business at the highest levels of efficiency and integrity, thus maximising the benefits for good causes, players and Irish society.

Review of Operations

Following a strong performance in 2006 when sales grew by 10.2%, I am delighted to report that the performance in the year under review again showed extremely strong growth with a further 14.6% increase in sales. Our turnover for the year reached a record high of €778.5 million compared to €679.1 million in 2006, enabling us to raise a record €245.5 million for good causes.

PLAYERS

2007 was a great year for players. 54% of the adult population now play lottery games frequently. They shared a record €420.9 million in prizes during the year, up €58.8 million from €362.1 million the previous year.

Throughout 2007 we continued to focus strongly on the preferences of our players as the basis for implementing changes to our games and prize structure.

Our players responded well to the new Lotto game structure introduced in late 2006 and we had a fantastic year of wins. Great excitement was experienced by players with many Lotto jackpot rollovers. We also provided a wide array of scratchcard games.

The good luck continued for players who became winners in 2007. The total jackpot money paid out to players was €112.9 million up from €88.2 million in 2006. 13 lucky Lotto winners became millionaires in 2007, and there were also 19 Lotto jackpot groups who won over €100 million between them.

DRAW GAMES

Combined sales of our draw games – Lotto, Lotto Plus, EuroMillions and Plus – increased by 19% from €507.2 million to €603.9 million in 2007 which was an impressive performance.

These games accounted for 77.6% of our total business and we continued to introduce innovative developments during 2007 with the launch of EuroMillions Plus – a new addition to the EuroMillions draw.

Lotto Games

The overall Lotto Games category grew significantly during 2007 and finished the year up 29.5% to €468.7 million from €361.9 million in 2006.

The big driver here was the Lotto game where players benefited from all jackpots starting at €2 million and increased prizes across all categories. Lotto sales increased by 40.2% to €357.7 compared with €255.1 million in the previous year. This was the largest ever growth in the Lotto game and illustrates how well suited the new game format is to our players in a contemporary Ireland.

The highlight of the year was undoubtedly the record €16,185,749 Lotto jackpot win by the Cunningham family from Cork in July. This was the largest rollover since the previous record of €8 million in 1996 and captured the imagination of the country generating huge excitement over six weeks.

In all there were 13 jackpots greater than €3 million, three of which were over €10 million. At the end of the year we had another exciting series of rollovers culminating in a Christmas jackpot of €13,295,379 which was won by a group from Galway. Throughout the year, Lotto players participated in the excitement of seven draws where the jackpot exceeded €5 million.

In 2007, there were 13 new Lotto millionaires. The total amount of money won by Lotto players in 2007 was €186.0 million and €112,890,982 was paid out in jackpot prizes. During the year there were 173 Match 5 plus Bonus wins.

Lotto Plus also performed very well with a 4.7% increase in sales to a record high of €100.1 million. The Lotto Plus games continued to be an integral part of the Lotto game with 85% of players opting to participate in both Lotto and Lotto Plus draws. During the year there were 30 winners of the top Lotto Plus 1 prize of €350,000, while 23 players won the €250,000 top prize on the Lotto Plus 2 draw. A further 161 lucky players won Match 5 plus bonus prizes on Lotto Plus 1 and 128 players won the same prize category on Lotto Plus 2.

On the October bank holiday weekend, we held our first ever outdoor broadcast of the Lotto draw at the Cork Opera House, a recipient of National Lottery funding. This was a hugely popular event with players and agents and attracted large crowds. We look forward to repeating the experience of holding the Lotto draw outside Dublin in 2008.

We also had three special Lotto draws during 2007 including the additional prize of a Saab convertible car worth €50,000 for all Match 5 plus bonus winners in June and September and a guaranteed €100 prize for all Match 4 winners in October. These prize innovations add to the attractiveness of the game for our players and create extra excitement on bank holiday weekends in particular.

Sales of Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 amounted to nearly €11 million. With an attractive prize payout level of 66%, Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 continues to provide an important game for players who prefer higher chances of winning smaller prizes. Those players shared €7.2 million in prizes during 2007.

The Cunningham Family from Fairhill in Cork city became the biggest Lotto winners ever when they won a Lotto jackpot worth over €16 million in July 2007.

This was the largest Lotto jackpot ever played for in Ireland since the game began in 1988. This particular jackpot started to roll on 20 June, 2007 and reached its 12th draw before the Cunninghams, with a €4 Quickpick ticket, won on Saturday 28 July, 2007, six weeks later. In the course of this jackpot roll, record sales of Lotto tickets were recorded, and raised a record €20 million for National Lottery good causes.

EuroMillions

The performance of EuroMillions in Ireland during 2007 mirrored the experience of the eight other countries that are part of this pan European game. Following an exceptional year in 2006 when we had two full rollover sequences to the maximum €180 million, EuroMillions rollovers in 2007 were shorter, with a highest jackpot of €75 million. The exception was, of course, the two Super jackpots in February and September when €100 million was guaranteed.

On 9 February, the biggest single win of the year went to Belgium when €100 million was won. Then in September the €130 million Superjackpot prize was shared among 16 winners. This means that Ireland still holds the record for the largest ever individual European jackpot win in Europe with the world famous €115 million win by Dolores McNamara.

We had our biggest win of the year in Ireland in June when a couple from Cork won a €1,298,414 Match 5 plus one Star prize. A total of €59.4 million was won by Irish EuroMillions winners in 2007, representing an average weekly prize payout of over €1 million.

EuroMillions sales in Ireland in 2007 were €118.7 million. In addition, the launch of the EuroMillions Plus game in June generated sales of €16.4 million in just six months, bringing the overall total sales of EuroMillions related games to €135.2 million for 2007.

The new EuroMillions Plus game gives all EuroMillions players in Ireland the chance to enter the first five of their EuroMillions numbers into an extra draw every Friday. Players of this new game won a total of €8.9 million in prizes over the last six months of the year. Nine winners won the top €500,000 prize.

TellyBingo

As our popular TellyBingo game continued in its twice weekly lunchtime TV slot on RTE One TV, it generated sales of €13.7 million and provided great entertainment value for viewers. Its loyal group of players shared €9.9 million in prizes during 2007 representing a 72% prize payout level. In all there were over 1.2 million TellyBingo prize winners, including 24 Snowball winners, the largest of which was Pauline McDonnell from Foxford, Co. Mayo who won €65,000 in June.

EuroMillions

Fágann sé seo gur ag Éirinn atá an chraobh fós don ollduais aonair is mó san Eoraip nuair a bhuaigh Dolores McNamara a duais cháiliúil de €115 milliún.

Bhí an bua ba mhó le linn na bliana in Éirinn againn nuair a bhuaigh lánúin ó Chorcaigh duais Match 5 plus one Star arbh fhiú €1,298,414 í. Bhain buaiteoirí Éireannacha i EuroMillions i 2007 iomlán de €59.4 milliún, arbh ionann é agus íocaíocht sheachtainiúil duaiseanna de bhreis is €1 milliún.

SCRATCHCARD GAMES

The performance of our scratchcard side of the business in 2007 demonstrated the positive effects of our marketing strategy for these games. Over the last couple of years, we have been focussing on re-invigorating the scratchcard game offering for our many loyal customers and providing them with a range of choices both in terms of types of games and price points. Sales of scratchcard games reached a record €160.9 million during the year, an increase of 2.2% on the previous year's figure of €157.4 million. This continues a positive upturn in sales of scratchcards, following a decline in sales some years previously. We launched a total of 31 new games at prices ranging from €1 to €10.

The long running Winning Streak game continues to be the National Lottery's most popular scratchcard game with the new game variant 'Double Your Money' generating sales of €35 million over its two TV seasons – January to May and September to December. The show, which has the highest prize payout TV game in Europe, continues to be one of RTE's top rated shows regularly achieving viewership levels of 500,000 people.

Over the 38 weeks of the Winning Streak TV game show, hosted by Derek Mooney, players won the grand total of €10,827,570. This was shared by 190 participants on the show, together with 128 cars and 64 holidays. There were great celebrations in April when Winnie Wilson from Ballina, Co Mayo won €321,000, the highest prize of the year.

In addition to the TV game show, there were thousands of winners of prizes on the Winning Streak scratchcards where the chances of winning were high.

In June we launched the new TV game show and scratchcard, Trump Card, presented by Laura Woods. Over the 14 weeks of this popular show sales of €10.5 million were achieved and the total prize payout was €7.1 million, including €3.2 million was paid out in prizes to the 84 players selected to participate in the TV game show. In addition they shared a total of 14 cars and 16 holidays. The biggest single winner was Samantha Mc Carra from Castlepollard, Co Westmeath who won €103,315 in July.

Overall, €101.8 million was returned to our scratchcard players in prizes. In addition, various games included much sought after special prizes, for example, All Ireland final tickets on 'Clash of the Cash' and Easter eggs and city breaks on 'Easter Breakaway', and hampers and chocolates on our popular Christmas game.

We also continued our strategy of designing games to appeal as gifts. Congratulations was particularly successful this year and our €10 Christmas Countdown and High Fives pack were very popular for special occasions.

The National Lottery's sponsorship of Coronation Street on TV3 finished its second year in 2007 and is an innovative and successful way of promoting our range of scratchcard games to our players.

The average prize payout level on scratchcard games during 2007 was 63%.

OPERATIONS

On the operations side of the business, our business development strategy of expanding our retail network and developing our employee resource worked well to deliver the record 14.6% increase in sales.

Total operating costs were €112.1 million. This figure included cost of sales of €42.0 million and agents' bonuses and commissions of €48.4 or 6.2 % of sales. During the year we increased our number of agents to 3,623 up 134 from 3,489 in 2006, reflecting Ireland's increased population in recent years. Our administration costs were reduced to 2.4% of sales.

On the retail development side of the business, we installed an extra 127 ticket checkers, bringing the overall number of ticket checkers to 1,320. We plan to extend this service to all Lotto agents during 2008.

We increased our number of permanent employees by five to 83 during the year as part of our business development strategy. Internationally, many lotteries use a 'sales per employee' ratio as a measure of efficiency, and Ireland compares very well in this regard with €9.4 million sales per employee.

Throughout the year our systems and technology supported six draw games with a total of 601 draws and over 246 million ticket transactions.

In 2007 we completed our review of our telecommunications requirements and have an approved plan to convert the majority of Lotto retail sites to wired broadband DSL in 2008.

During the year we developed and tested our games for internet and mobile phone and prepared for a player launch.

2007 was an extremely busy year for the National Lottery and I would like to thank my colleagues, our agents, the board, our regulator and our shareholders for their tremendous hard work during the year. Their energy and commitment were fundamental to our successful performance.

GOOD CAUSES

The raising of €245.5 million for distribution to good causes during 2007 set a new record and brings the cumulative amount of funds raised over the 20 years of the National Lottery to €2.85 billion. We are confident that we will bring this figure to over €3 billion next year.

Thousands of projects are supported each year by National Lottery funding. The examples of where this money goes really bring home the benefits of the funds raised by National Lottery players. Some examples of good causes which received funding in 2007 are as follows:

The newly refurbished *Waterford Regional Sports Centre* provides full leisure facilities to the local community and meets the training and coaching needs of competitive players and athletes. The Sports Complex is also home to Waterford United FC. Built by Waterford City Council in a Public Private Partnership, it received €750,000 in National Lottery funding last year from the Department of Arts Sports and Tourism, bringing its total Lottery funding to €6.4 million.

The 2007 *Special Olympics World Summer Games* ran in October in Shanghai, China with 7,200 athletes from 165 nations and regions taking part. TEAM Ireland, comprising of 141 athletes and their 55 coaches, had an outstanding performance at the Games, winning a total of 119 Medals and 69 Ribbons in 11 sports; Aquatics, Athletics, Badminton, Basketball, Bocce, Bowling, Equestrian, Football, Golf, Gymnastics and Table-Tennis. 200 Irish volunteers also travelled to the Special Olympics World Summer Games to support TEAM Ireland. The Department of Health allocated €45,000 in National Lottery funds towards the cost of delivering a vaccination programme to the Special Olympics Ireland Team members participating in the Special Olympics in China.

Based at the University of Limerick, the *Irish Chamber Orchestra* has gained a remarkable reputation as a fresh and vibrant force on the Irish and international music scene. Under Artistic Director, Anthony Marwood, the orchestra is one of the country's world-class cultural assets. It has commissioned and performed many new works by Irish composers, both nationally and internationally and has facilitated the artistic and professional development of many of the country's most talented classical musicians. In 2007 the Irish Chamber Orchestra received funding of €1.3 million from the Arts Council which is part funded by the National Lottery Beneficiary Fund through the Department of Arts, Sports and Tourism.

Soláthraíonn *Ionad Réigiúnach Spóirt Phort Láirge*, a osclaíodh le déanaí, áiseanna iomlán fóillíochta don phobal áitiúil agus freastalaíonn sé ar riachtanais traenála agus oiliúna imreoirí iomaíochta. Tá an tIonad Spóirt mar bhaile freisin ag club sacair Waterford United. Thóg Comhairle Chathrach Phort Láirge é i gcomhpháirtíocht phríobháideach phoiblí agus fuair sé €750,000 d'airgead an Chrannchuir anuraidh ón Roinn Ealaíon, Spóirt agus Turasóireachta. €6.4m ina iomláine atá faighte aige d'airgead an Chrannchuir.

Bhí Cluichí Samhraidh Domhanda na nOilimpicí Speisialta ar siúl mí Dheireadh Fómhair i Shanghai sa tSín. Ghlac 7,200 lúthchleasaí ó 165 náisiún agus réigiún páirt iontu. Bhí torthaí thar cionn ag TEAM Ireland, ar a raibh 141 lúthchleasaí agus 55 cóitseálaí, ag na Cluichí. Bhuaigh siad 119 Bonn, agus 69 Ribín in aon spórt déag: Spóirt Uisceacha, Lúthchleasa, Badmantan, Cispheil, Bocce, Babhláil, Eachaíocht, Peil, Galf, Gleacaíocht agus Leadóg Bhoird. Thaisteal 200 oibrí deonach Éireannach go dtí Cluichí Samhraidh Domhanda na nOilimpicí Speisialta chun tacú le TEAM Ireland. Dháil an Roinn Sláinte €45,000 d'airgead an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta ar scéim vacsaínithe do chomhaltaí fhoireann na hÉireann a bhí ag glacadh páirt sna hOilimpicí Speisialta sa tSín.

Tá cáil bainte amach ag *Ceolfhoireann Aireagail na hÉireann*, atá lonnaithe in Ollscoil Luimnigh, mar fhórsa úr, bríomhar, i saol ceoil na hÉireann agus go hidirnáisiúnta. Agus Anthony Marwood mar Stiúrtóir Ealaíne uirthi, tá an ceolfhoireann ina shócmhainn chultúrtha, ar chaighdeán domhanda, ag an tír seo. Choimisiúnaigh agus sheinn sí go leor píosaí ceoil ó chumadóirí Éireannacha go náisiúnta agus go hidirnáisiúnta. Thairis sin, d'éascaigh sí forbairt phroifisiúnta go leor de shár-cheoltóirí clasaiceacha na tíre. I 2007 fuair Ceolfhoireann Aireagail na hÉireann maoiniú de €1.3 milliún ón gComhairle Ealaíon a fhaigheann páirt mhaoiniú ó Chiste Thairbhithe an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta tríd an Roinn Ealaíon, Spóirt agus Turasóireachta.

Bord na Leabhar Gaeilge supports writers and publishers in providing Irish language publications, which boost the general public's interest in Irish language books. This support is given through schemes such as Scéim na Foilsitheoireachta and Scéimeanna Scríbhneoireachta. The accomplishments of publishers and writers alike are recognised through the Book of the Year competition, run in partnership with Oireachtas na Gaeilge. Budding young writers are also encouraged through 'Scríobh Leabhar', organised in conjunction with the Comhairle um Oideachas Gaeltachta agus Gaelscolaíochta and Educational Institutes. Through this scheme, primary school children are encouraged to write books in Irish. Primary school students from inside and outside the Gaeltacht wrote 1,198 books under this pilot scheme. Last year Bord na Leabhar Gaeilge received €2.07 million from Ciste na Gaeilge, funded by the National Lottery Beneficiary Fund through the Department of Community Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs.

THE FUTURE

As part of the review of the business which we commenced in 2005 we have undertaken work on the development of a more contemporary and co-ordinated image for the National Lottery. This will more appropriately reflect the company's vision. The new corporate identity will be introduced across all aspects of the National Lottery's operations over the coming year and we believe that it will have a very positive effect on the future development of the business.

During 2008 we plan to particularly focus on the retail dimension of the business, introducing new developments in line with the expressed preferences of players and agents. We believe that these developments will re-energise the National Lottery as it enters its third decade of operating a world-class lottery for the people of Ireland and continues to raise funds for good causes.

We are fully committed to delivering continued business efficiency with integrity and innovation as we work successfully as a team.

Spreagann an scéim seo daltaí bunscóile chun scaoileadh faoi leabhair i nGaeilge a scríobh. Faoin treoir-scéim seo, scríobh daltaí bunscóile ón nGaeltacht agus taobh amuigh di, 1,198 leabhar. An bhliain seo caite, fuair Bord na Leabhar Gaeilge €2.07 milliún ó Chiste na Gaeilge, a mhaoínítear le hairgead ó Chiste Thairbhíthe an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta tríd an Roinn Gnóthaí Pobail, Tuaithe agus Gaeltachta.

A BHFUIL ROMHAINN AMACH

Mar chuid den athmheastóireacht ar an ngnó a thosaíomar i 2005, chuamar i mbun oibre chun iomhá níos comhaimseartha agus comhordaithe don Chrannchur Náisiúnta a fhorbairt. Is fearr a fhreagróidh sí seo d'fhís an chomhlachta. Tógfar an comhionannas nua corparáideach isteach i ngach gné d'oibríochtaí an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta thar an mbliain atá romhainn amach agus creidim go mbeidh éifeacht dhearfach aige ar fhorbairt an ghnó amach anseo.

Le linn 2008, tá rún againn díriú ar ghné miondíola an ghnó agus scaoileadh faoi fhorbairtí nua mar atá ag teastáil ó imreoirí agus ó ghníomhairí. Creidimid go gcuirfidh na forbairtí seo fuinneamh nua sa Chrannchur Náisiúnta agus é ag tabhairt aghaidh ar an tríú tréimhse deich mbliana dá shaolré agus é ag reáchtáil crannchur de chaighdeán domhanda do mhuintir na hÉireann agus ag gnóthú airgead do dhea chúiseanna.

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The Directors have pleasure in submitting their twenty first annual report, together with the audited financial statements of the Company, for the year ended 31 December, 2007, in fulfilment of their obligations under the Companies Acts, 1963 to 2006.

1. The Company

The Company carries on the business of operating the National Lottery under Licence from the Minister for Finance in accordance with the provisions of the National Lottery Act, 1986.

80% of the issued share capital is held by An Post and 20% is held by the Minister for Finance.

2. Results for the Year

The results for the year are set out on page 40.

3. Business Review

The information required by Section 13 of the Companies (Amendment) Act, 1986, on the development of the business and important events, is included in the Chairman's Statement and Review of Operations on pages 8 to 23. As described therein, the performance of the Company was again very positive with sales growing by 14.6%, in part driven by the inclusion of a full year of Lotto 6/45 matrix revenue and the introduction of the Euromillions Plus game in 2007.

As a result, €245 million was raised for the beneficiary fund in 2007, compared to €218 million in 2006.

In monitoring the Company's performance, the Directors and management have regard to a range of key performance indicators (KPIs).

The above KPIs are within the terms of the Licence to operate the National Lottery.

The key risks and uncertainties facing the future development of the Company include the retention of the Company's licence to operate the National Lottery, the Company's significant reliance upon its IT infrastructure and retailer operations and the introduction of new games and channels. The Directors have developed a range of strategies to address these and other risks faced by the Company. The Corporate Governance Statement on page 27 sets out the Company's policies and approach to risks and the related internal control procedures and responsibilities.

4. Directors, Secretary and their interests

The Directors of the Company are appointed by the Minister for Finance in accordance with Section 14 of the National Lottery Act, 1986.

The terms of office of Niamh McGowan and Paraic O'Rourke expired on 5 November, 2007. Niamh McGowan was re-appointed from that date.

The Directors and Secretary who held office at 31 December, 2007 had no interest in, shares in, or debentures of, the Company or any Group Company.

Ní raibh leas tairbhíuil ná scaireanna sa Chomhlacht ná bintiúir a bhain leis nó le haon Ghrúp-Chuideachta ag na Stiúrthóirí ná ag an Rúnaí a bhí in oifig ar 31 Nollaig, 2007.

5. Employees

The Company and An Post, which provides seconded staff to the Company, are equal opportunities employers. All applications for employment are given full and fair consideration, due regard being given to the aptitude and ability of the individual and the requirements of the position concerned.

All persons are treated on equal terms as regards training, career development and promotion.

The well-being of staff working in the Company is safeguarded through the strict adherence to health and safety standards. The Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act, 2005 imposes certain requirements in respect of staff and the Company has taken the necessary action to ensure compliance with the Act, including the adoption of a Safety Statement.

6. Corporate Governance

Maintaining high standards of corporate governance continues to be a priority of the Directors of An Post National Lottery Company. The Board has developed its corporate governance policy so as to give effect to the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies issued by the Department of Finance and to apply as appropriate the relevant main and supporting principles of good governance in the 2006 Combined Code issued by the Financial Reporting Council in the UK. While the provisions of the Combined Code are of direct relevance only to listed companies, the Board feels that their application, where appropriate, assists the Company in its compliance with best corporate governance practice.

The Directors are accountable to the shareholders for good corporate governance and this report addresses how the relevant main and supporting principles of the Code of Best Practice for the Governance of State Bodies and the 2006 Combined Code have been applied within An Post National Lottery Company.

The Board

The Company is controlled through its Board of Directors. The Board's main roles are to oversee the operation of the Company, to provide leadership to the Company, to approve the Company's strategic objectives and to ensure that the necessary financial and other resources are made available to enable them to meet those objectives. The Board, which meets monthly during the year, has a schedule of matters reserved for its approval.

The specific responsibilities reserved to the Board include: setting Company strategy and approving an annual budget and medium-term projections; reviewing operational and financial performance; approving major capital expenditure; ensuring compliance with the terms of the licence to operate the National Lottery, reviewing the Company's systems of financial control and risk management; ensuring that appropriate management development and succession plans are in place; reviewing the environmental, health and safety performance of the Company; approving the appointment of the Company Secretary; and ensuring that a satisfactory dialogue takes place with shareholders.

The Board has delegated the following responsibilities to management: the development and recommendation of strategic plans for consideration by the Board that reflect the longer-term objectives and priorities established by the Board; implementation of the strategies and policies of the Company as determined by the Board; monitoring of the operating and financial results against plans and budgets; development of controls over the operation of draws, prioritising the allocation of technical and human resources; and developing and implementing risk management systems.

5. Fostaithe

Caitear le gach duine ar bhonn cothrom chomh fada is a bhaineann sé le hoiliúint, le forbairt gearme agus le hardú céime a thabhairt.

Déantar cúram de dhearbhaíl na foirne, atá ag obair leis an gComhlacht trí chloí go docht le caighdeán shábháilteachta agus sláinte. Leagann An tAcht um Sábháilteacht, Sláinte agus Leas ag an Obair, 2005, dualgais áirithe i leith na foirne agus tá na céimeanna riachtanacha glactha ag an gComhlacht chun déanamh de réir an Achte. Áirítear orthusan glacadh le Ráiteas Sábháilteachta.

6. Rialachas Corparáide

Tosaíocht é ag Stiúrthóirí Chomhlacht Chrannchur Náisiúnta an Phoist ardchaighdeán rialachais corparáide a choinneáil. D'fhorbair an Bord a pholasáil ar rialachas corparáide le go mbeadh feidhm ag an gCód Sárchleachtais um Rialachas Chomhlachtaí Stáit a d'eisigh an Roinn Airgeadais agus chun feidhm a thabhairt nuair is cuí do príomhphrionsabail agus do phrionsabail thacaíochta ábhartha um dhearbhalachas atá sa Chomhchód a d'eisigh an Financial Reporting Council sa Ríocht Aontaithe i 2006. Siúd is go mbaineann forálacha an Chomhchóid go díreach le cuideachtaí liostáilte amháin, braitheann an Bord go gcuideoin a bhfeidhmiú mar is cuí leis an gComhlacht chun sár-chleachtas rialachais corparáide a chomhlíonadh.

Is iad príomhról an Bhoird maoirseacht a dhéanamh ar oibríochtaí an Chomhlachta, cinneacht a sholáthar don Chomhlacht, cuspóirí straitéiseacha an Chomhlachta a fhaomhadh agus deimhin a dhéanamh de go gcuirtear ar fáil na hacmhainní riachtanacha airgeadais agus eile chun gur féidir leo na cuspóirí sin a bhaint amach. Uair sa mhí a thagann an Bord le chéile le linn na bliana. Tá sceideal ábhar atá forchoimeáda le fhaomhadh ag an mBord.

I measc na sainfhreagrachtaí atá forchoimeáda don Bord tá: straitéis an Chomhlachta a cheapadh; an buiséad bliantúil agus na réamh-mheastacháin mheántéarmacha a fhaomhadh; feidhmiú oibríochta agus airgeadais a athbhreithniú; mórchaiteachas caipitil a fhaomhadh; deimhin a dhéanamh de go bhfuil téarmaí an cheadúnais chun an Crannchur Náisiúnta a reáchtáil á gcomhlíonadh; córais an Chomhlachta um rialú airgeadais agus bainistíú riosca a athbhreithniú; deimhin a dhéanamh de go bhfuil pleananna cuí i bhfeidhm chun forbairt agus comharbaíocht na bainistíochta a chinntiú; feidhmiú an Chomhlachta ó thaobh na timpeallachta agus cúrsaí sláinte is sábháilteachta de a athbhreithniú; ceapadh Rúnaí an Chomhlachta a fhaomhadh; deimhin a dhéanamh de go mbíonn idirphlé sásúil ann leis na scairshealbhoirí.

Tá na freagrachtaí seo a leanas tarmligthe ag an mBord don bhainistíocht: pleananna straitéiseacha, a bheadh ag teacht le cuspóirí agus le tosaíochtaí fadtéarmacha an Bhoird, a cheapadh agus a mholadh don Bhord le scrúdú; straitéisí agus polasaithe an Chomhlachta, mar atá sonraíte ag an mBord, a fheidhmiú; faireachán a dhéanamh ar thorthaí oibríochta agus airgeadais i gcomparáid le pleananna agus le buiséid; córais rialaithe a fhorbairt do reáchtáil na gcrannchur; tosaíochtaí a cheapadh do chionroinnt acmhainní daonna is teicniúla; agus córais bainistíochta riosca a cheapadh is a chur i bhfeidhm.

The roles of the Chairman and Chief Executive

The Chairman leads the Board in the determination of its strategy and in the achievement of its objectives. The Chairman is responsible for organising the business of the Board, ensuring its effectiveness and setting its agenda. The Chairman facilitates the effective contribution of non-executive Directors and constructive relations between the executive Director and non-executive Directors, ensures that Directors receive accurate, timely and clear information and manages effective communication with shareholders.

The Chief Executive has direct charge of the Company on a day to day basis and is accountable to the Board for the financial and operational performance of the Company.

Senior Independent Director

The Board has considered the matter of designating a recognised senior member other than the Chairman to whom concerns can be conveyed and, in view of the manner of appointment of Directors, the shareholding structure and existing Board procedures, has concluded it is not appropriate in the circumstances.

Directors and Directors' independence

The Board currently comprises the Chairman, four non-executive Directors and the Chief Executive. The names of the Directors together with their biographical details are set out on page 24. The positions of Chairman and Chief Executive are held by different persons. Given its status as a State Company, its shareholding structure and the appointment of the Directors by the Minister, the Board believes that the criteria normally used by the board of a listed Company in considering the independence of its Directors do not apply to the Company. The Board includes independent non-executive Directors who constructively challenge and help develop proposals on strategy, bring strong, independent judgement, knowledge, and experience to the Board's deliberations. The independent Directors are of sufficient calibre and number that their views carry significant weight in the Board's decision making.

The 2006 Combined Code requires the Chairman to hold meetings with the non-executive Directors without the executive Director being present. The Board has formal procedures in place in this regard.

Directors have the right to ensure that any concerns they have, which cannot be resolved, about the running of the Company or a proposed action, are recorded in the Board minutes. In addition, upon resignation, a non-executive Director will be asked to provide a written statement to the Chairman, for circulation to the Board, if they have any such concerns.

The Directors are given access to independent professional advice at the Company's expense, when the Directors deem it is necessary in order for them to carry out their responsibilities.

All of the non-executive Directors are independent of management. The Board includes both the chief executive of the Company's parent company, An Post, as Chairman and James Hyland, a non-executive director of An Post. The Board considers all other non-executive Directors to be independent on the basis of the following:

- they have not been an employee of the Company within the last five years;
- they have no material business relationship with the Company, nor have they had any within the last three years;
- they receive no remuneration other than through Director's fees;
- they have no close family ties with any of the Company's advisers, Directors or senior employees; and
- they hold no cross-directorships and have no significant links with other Directors through involvement in other companies or bodies.

Ról an Chathaoirleach agus an Phríomhfheidhmeannaigh

Is é An Cathaoirleach a threoraíonn an Bord maidir le cinneadh polasaí agus le baint amach a chuid cuspóirí. Is é an Cathaoirleach atá freagrach as gnó an Bhoird a eagrú, as a éifeacht a chinntiú agus as an clár gnó a shocrú. Éascaíonn an Cathaoirleach rannpháirtíocht éifeachtach na Stiúrthóirí neamh-fheidhmiúcháin agus deachaidreamh idir iad agus an Stiúrthóir feidhmiúcháin agus cinntiann sé go bhfaigheann na Stiúrthóirí eolas cruinn, tráthúil agus soiléir. Bainistionn sé freisin cumarsáid éifeachtach leis na scairshealbhoirí.

Is ag Príomhfheidhmeannach an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta atá údarás díreach ar an gComhlacht ó lá go chéile agus tá sé freagrach don Bhard as feidhmiú oibríoch agus airgeadais an Chomhlachta.

Stiúrthóir Sínearach Neamhspleách

Scrúdaigh an Bord an fhéidearthacht go gceapfaí comhalta sínearach inaitheanta, seachas an Cathaoirleach, mar dhuine go bhféadfaí ábhair imní a chur faoina bhráid. I ngeall ar an tslí ina gceaptar Stiúrthóirí, struchtúr an scairchaipitil agus gnáthaimh reatha an Bhoird, shocraigh an Bord nach mbeadh a leithéid de shocrú oiriúnach faoi láthair.

Stiúrthóirí agus Neamhspleáchas na Stiúrthóirí

San am i láthair, is iad comhaltaí an Bhoird an Cathaoirleach, ceathrar Stiúrthóirí neamh-fheidhmiúcháin agus an Príomhfheidhmeannach. Tá ainmneacha na Stiúrthóirí mar aon le sonraí beathaisnéise orthu leagtha amach ar leathanach 24. Daoine difriúla atá i bpost an Chathaoirleach agus i bpost Phríomhfheidhmeannach an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta. Nuair a chuirtear san áireamh gur comhlacht Stáit atá i gceist, struchtúr an scairchaipitil agus gurb é an tAire a cheapann na Stiúrthóirí, measann an Bord nach dtugann na gnáth-chritéir, a d'úsáidfeadh stiúrthóirí chuideachta liostáilte chun neamhspleáchas a Stiúrthóirí a mheas, i bhfeidhm sa chás seo. Áirítear ar an mBord Stiúrthóirí neamh-fheidhmiúcháin neamhspleácha a cheistíonn ar bhealach dearfach moltaí faoi chúrsaí straitéise agus a chabhraíonn le hiad a fhorbairt. Thairis sin, tugann siad breithiúnas láidir, neamhspleách, maille le heolas agus taithí agus ceisteanna á scrúdú ag an mBord. Tá na Stiúrthóirí neamhspleácha líonmhar a dhóthain agus de chaidéan sách ard le go mbeadh tionchar nach beag ag a dtuairimí ar chinntí an Bhoird.

Faoi Chomhchód 2006 tá dualgas ar an gCathaoirleach cruinnithe a bheith aige leis na Stiúrthóirí neamh-fheidhmiúcháin gan an Stiúrthóir feidhmiúcháin a bheith i láthair. Tá gnáthaimh fhoirmeálta chuige seo i bhfeidhm ag an mBord.

Tá sé de cheart ag Stiúrthóirí deimhin a dhéanamh de go gléaraítear i miontuairiscí an Bhoird aon ábhar imní gan réiteach atá acu faoi réachtáil an Chomhlachta nó faoi bheart atá molta. De bhreis air sin, iarrfar ar aon Stiúrthóir neamh-fheidhmiúcháin a éiríonn as oifig, ráiteas i scríbhinn a thabhairt don Chathaoirleach, le cur thart ar an mBord, má tá aon ábhar imní aige.

Cuirtear comhairle neamhspleách phroifisiúnta ar fáil do na Stiúrthóirí ar chostas an Chomhlachta má shíleann na Stiúrthóirí go bhfuil gá lena leithéid le go bhfeadfaidís a gcuid dualgas a chomhlíonadh.

Tá na Stiúrthóirí neamh-fheidhmiúcháin uile neamhspleách ar an mbainistiúcht. Comhaltaí den Bhard iad príomhfheidhmeannach mháthair-chuideachta an Chomhlachta, An Post, atá ina Chathaoirleach, agus James Hyland, stiúrthóir neamh-fheidhmiúcháin ar An Post. Measann an Bord na Stiúrthóirí neamh-fheidhmiúcháin eile a bheith neamhspleách ar an mBord seo a leanas:

- nárbh fhostaí ag an gComhlacht iad le cúig bliana anuas;
- nach bhfuil aon ghaol gnó ábhartha acu leis an gComhlacht agus nach raibh aon ghaol den chineál sin acu le trí bliana anuas;
- nach bhfuil aon luach saothair, seachas a dtáillí mar Stiúrthóirí, á fháil acu;
- nach bhfuil aon ghaol gairid clainne acu le haon chomhairleoir, stiúrthóir nó fostaí sínearach de chuid an Chomhlachta; agus
- nach bhfuil tras-stiúrthóireachtaí acu ná aon cheangal suaithinseach le Stiúrthóirí eile trí chuideachtaí nó comhlachtaí eile.

Professional development

On appointment, all new Directors take part in an induction programme when they receive information about the Company, the role of the Board and the matters reserved for its decision, the terms of reference and membership of the principal Board and Board committees, the Company's corporate governance practices and procedures, including the responsibilities delegated to Company senior management, and the latest financial information about the Company. This will typically be supplemented by meetings with key senior executives. Throughout their period in office, the Directors are continually updated on the Company's business, the competitive and regulatory environments in which it operates, corporate social responsibility matters and other changes affecting the Company and the lottery industry as a whole, by written briefings and meetings with senior executives. Directors are also advised on appointment of their legal and other duties and obligations as a Director, both in writing and in face-to-face meetings with the Company Secretary. They are also updated on changes to the legal and governance requirements of the Company and upon themselves as Directors.

Performance evaluation

All Directors are appointed to the Board by the Minister for Finance in accordance with Section 14 of the National Lottery Act, 1986 and their terms of office (generally three years) are set out in writing.

The Board has adopted and performed a formal process for the annual evaluation of the performance of the Board and its principal Committees. The Board considers that the introduction of any further formal evaluation of individual Directors would be inappropriate given the manner of appointment of Directors, the shareholding structure and existing Board procedures.

The Company Secretary

The Company Secretary is a full time employee of the Company's parent company, An Post. The Company Secretary is responsible for advising the Board, through the Chairman, on all governance matters. All Directors have access to the advice and services of the Company Secretary. The Company's Articles of Association provide that the appointment and removal of the Company Secretary is a matter for the full Board.

Information

Regular reports and papers are circulated to the Directors in a timely manner in preparation for Board and Committee meetings. These papers are supplemented by information specifically requested by the Directors from time to time.

The non-executive Directors receive monthly management accounts and regular management reports and information which enables them to scrutinise the Company's and management's performance against agreed objectives.

Relations with shareholders

The Board and management maintain an ongoing dialogue with the Company's shareholders on strategic issues. In addition, under the National Lottery Act, 1986, certain operational matters require the approval of the Minister for Finance in respect of which ongoing contact with the Minister is maintained.

The Chairman gives feedback to the Board on issues raised with him by the shareholders. All Directors normally attend the Annual General Meeting and shareholders are invited to ask questions during the meeting and to meet with Directors after the formal proceedings have ended.

Forbairt Phroifisiúnta

Ar a gceapadh dóibh glacann na Stiúrthóirí nua go léir páirt i gcúrsa intreorach mar a bhfaigheann siad eolas i dtaobh an Chomhlachta, ar ról an Bhoird agus na nithe atá forchoimeáda dá chinneadh, ar théarmaí tagartha agus ar bhallaíocht an Phríomh-Bhoird agus choistí an Bhoird, ar chleachta is ar ghnáthaimh rialachais chorparáidigh an Chomhlachta, ina measc na freagrachtaí atá tarmlichte le bainisteoirí sinsearacha an Chomhlachta, maille leis an eolas airgeadais is déanaí faoin gComhlacht. De ghnáth, cuirtear leis seo trí chruinnithe le heochair-fheidhmeannaigh sinsearacha. Le linn a dtréimhsí oifige coinnítear Stiúrthóirí suas chun dáta ar ghnóthaí an Chomhlachta, ar na tosca iomaíocha agus rialála faoin a bhfuil sé ag gníomhú, ar fhreagracht shóisialta chorparáideach agus ar athruithe eile a bhfuil éifeacht acu ar an gComhlacht agus ar thionscal na gcrannchur ina iomláine. Déantar é seo trí mhionteagasc i scríbhinn agus trí chruinnithe le feidhmeannaigh shinsearacha. Cuirtear Stiúrthóirí ar an eolas freisin faoin a gcuid dualgas dlíthiúla agus eile mar Stiúrthóirí. Déantar é seo i scríbhinn agus ag cruinnithe i láthair Rúnaí an Chomhlachta. Coinnítear suas chun dáta iad chomh maith faoi athruithe i riachtanais dlíthiúla agus rialachais an Chomhlachta agus a gcuid féin mar Stiúrthóirí.

Meastóireacht ar Fheidhmiú

Ceapann an tAire Airgeadais na Stiúrthóirí ar an mBord faoi réir Alt 14 den Acht um Chrannchur Náisiúnta, 1986 agus leagtar amach a dtréimhsí oifige (trí bliana sa ghnáthshli) i scríbhinn.

Tá glactha ag an mBord le próiseas foirmiúil chun meastóireacht bhliantúil a dhéanamh ar fheidhmiú an Bhoird agus a príomhchoistí. Tá an Bord den tuairim nach mbeadh aon mheastóireacht fhoirmiúil bhreise ar Stiúrthóirí aonair cuí nuair a chuirtear san áireamh an tsli ina gceaptar Stiúrthóirí, an struchtúr scairsheilbhe agus na gnáthaimh atá ag an mBord faoi láthair.

Rúnaí an Chomhlachta

Fostaí de chuid na máthair-chuideachta, An Post, é Rúnaí an Chomhlachta. Tá Rúnaí an Chomhlachta freagrach as eolas a choinneáil leis an mBord tríd an gCathaoirleach ar gach gnó rialachais. Tá fáil ag na Stiúrthóirí uile ar chomhairle is ar sheirbhísí Rúnaí an Chomhlachta. Faoi réir na nAirteagal Comhlachais is gnó don Bhorid ina iomláine é Rúnaí an Chomhlachta a cheapadh is a bhreisdh.

Eolas

Cuirtear tuarascála agus páipéir thart ar na Stiúrthóirí in am tráth do chruinnithe Boird is Coistí. Cuirtear leis na páipéir seo trí eolas ar leith a sholáthar de réir mar a iarrann Stiúrthóirí é ó am go chéile.

Faigheann na Stiúrthóirí neamhfheidhmiúcháin cuntais mhíosúla bainistíochta maille le tuairiscí agus eolas rialta ón mbainistíocht, rud a chuireann ar a gcumas mionscrúdú a dhéanamh ar fheidhmiú na bainistíochta agus an Chomhlachta i gcomparáid le spriocanna aontaithe.

Caidreamh le Scairshealbhóirí

Bionn idirphlé leanúnach idir an Bord is an bhainistíocht le scairshealbhóirí an Chomhlachta faoi nithe straitéiseacha. Thairis sin, faoin Acht um Chrannchur Náisiúnta 1986, ní mór faomhadh an Aire Airgeadais a fháil do ghnóthaí oibríocha áirithe agus chuige sin coinnítear teagmháil leanúnach leis an Aire.

Tugann an Cathaoirleach aiseolas don Bhorid ar cheisteanna a thóg na scairshealbhóirí leis. Is gnách leis na Stiúrthóirí uile freastal ar an gCruinniú Cinnbhliana agus tugtar cuireadh do na scairshealbhóirí ceisteanna a chur le linn an chruinnithe agus casadh ar na Stiúrthóirí nuair a bhíonn deireadh leis na himeachtaí foirmiúla.

Internal Control

An ongoing process exists for identifying, evaluating and managing the significant risks faced by the Company. This process, which is based on the Combined Code Guidance for directors issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales (the Turnbull Guidance), is periodically reviewed by the Directors and has been in place throughout the accounting period and up to the date the financial statements were approved.

In accordance with the guidance of the Turnbull committee, the Directors are responsible for the Company's system of internal control, should set appropriate policies on internal control, should seek regular assurance that will enable them to satisfy themselves that the system is functioning effectively and should ensure that the system of internal control is effective in managing risks in the manner which it has approved. Such a system is designed to manage rather than eliminate business risks and can provide only reasonable rather than absolute assurance against material misstatement or loss.

The Directors have continued to review the effectiveness of the Company's system of financial and non-financial controls, including operational and compliance controls, risk management and the Company's high level internal control arrangements. These reviews have included an assessment of internal controls by management, management assurance of the maintenance of controls, reports from the internal auditor and reports from the external auditor on matters identified in the course of its statutory audit work.

The Company views the careful management of risk as a key management activity. Managing business risk to deliver opportunities is a key element of all activities. This is done using a simple and flexible framework which provides a consistent and sustained way of implementing the Company's values. These business risks, which may be strategic, operational, reputational, financial or environmental, should be understood and visible. The business context determines in each situation the level of acceptable risk and controls.

Management is responsible for the identification and evaluation of significant risks and for the design and implementation of appropriate internal controls. These risks are assessed on an ongoing basis and are derived from a variety of external and internal sources. Management reports regularly to the Board on the key risks inherent in the business and on the way in which these risks are managed. Management also reports to the Board on any significant changes in the Company's business and on any risks associated with such changes. The process used to identify and manage key risks is an integral part of the internal control environment.

Rialú Inmheánach

Tá próiseas leanúnach ann chun na rioscaí suntasacha, a gcaitheann an Comhlacht aghaidh a thabhairt orthu, a aithint, a mheasúnú agus a bhainistiú. Tá an próiseas seo bunaithe ar Threoracha an Chomhchóid do stiúrthóirí a d'eisigh Institiúid na gCuntasóirí Cairte i Sasana agus sa Bhreatain Bheag (Treoracha Turnbull). Athbhreithníonn na Stiúrthóirí iad ó am go chéile agus bhí feidhm leo le linn na tréimhse cuntasáiochta suas go dtí an dáta ar a faomhadh na ráitis airgeadais.

Faoi réir na treorach a thugann coiste Turnbull, tá na Stiúrthóirí freagrach as córas rialaithe inmheánaigh an Chomhlachta. Ba chóir dóibh polasaithe cuí ar rialú inmheánach a shocrú, deimhniú a lorg go rialta a shásóidh iad go bhfuil an córas ag feidhmiú go héifeachtach agus ní mór dóibh a bheith sásta go bhfuil an córas rialaithe inmheánaigh éifeachtach chun rioscaí a bhainistiú ar an dóigh a faomhadh. Ceaptar córas mar seo chun rioscaí gnó a bhainistiú seachas fáil réidh leo agus ní thig leis ach barántas réasúnta, seachas barántas iomlán, a thabhairt in aghaidh aon mhíráiteas ábhartha nó cailleanas.

Lean na Stiúrthóirí de bheith ag athbhreithniú éifeacht chóras rialaithe airgeadais agus neamh-airgeadais an Chomhlachta, ina measc rialúcháin oibríoch agus oiriúna, bainistíocht rioscaí agus socrúithe rialaithe ardléibhéil an Chomhlachta. Mar chuid den athbhreithniú seo rinneadh meastóireacht ar rialúcháin inmheánacha na bainistíochta, ar dheimhniú na bhainistíochta go leantar den rialú, ar thuairiscí ón iniúchóir inmheánach agus ar thuairiscí ón iniúchóir seachtrach ar chúrsaí a aithníodh agus an obair reachtúil iniúchóireachta ar bun.

Tá an Comhlacht den tuairim gur eochair-ghníomhaíocht de chuid na bainistíochta é bainistiú cáiréiseach a dhéanamh ar rioscaí. Buneilimint in aon ghníomhaíocht é rioscaí gnó a bhainistiú chun deiseanna a thapú. Déantar é seo trí úsáid a bhaint as frámaíocht shimplí sholúbtha a chruthaíonn bealach buan agus seasmhach chun luachanna an Chomhlachta a chur i bhfeidhm. Ba chóir go mbeadh na rioscaí gnó seo, bídis ina rioscaí straitéiseacha, oibríoch, deacháile, airgeadais nó timpeallachta, intuigthe agus sofheicthe. In aon chúinse ar leith, is é an comhthéacs gnó a shocraíonn leibhéal inghlactha rialú rioscaí agus cinn ghaolmhara.

Ar an mbainistíocht atá an fhreagracht chun rioscaí suntasacha a aithint agus a mheas agus as rialúcháin inmheánacha cuí a cheapadh is a chur i bhfeidhm. Déantar meastóireacht leanúnach ar na rioscaí seo agus í bunaithe ar raon foinsí inmheánacha agus seachtracha. Tuairiscíonn an bhainistíocht go rialta don Bhord ar na príomh-rioscaí a bhaineann leis an ngnó agus ar an tslí ina ndéantar bainistiú ar na rioscaí. Tuairiscíonn an bhainistíocht don Bhord freisin ar athruithe suntasacha i ngnóthaí an Chomhlachta agus aon rioscaí a eascraíonn as na hathruithe seo. Dlúthchuid den timpeallacht inmheánach rialaithe é an próiseas a úsáidtear chun na príomh-rioscaí a aithint agus a bhainistiú.

Report of the Directors

Tuarascáil na Stiúrthóirí

The key procedures which the Directors have established with a view to providing effective internal control are as follows:

- A clear focus on business objectives as determined by the Board after consideration of the statutory responsibilities and risk profile of the Company's business.
- A defined organisational structure with clear lines of responsibility, delegation of authority and segregation of duties designed to foster a beneficial control environment.
- A risk management process which considers the strategy and development of the business in the context of the annual budget process when financial plans and performance targets are set and reviewed by the Board in light of the Company's overall objectives.
- A report and control system which produces a comprehensive set of financial reports. The annual budget is approved by the Board. Key financial statistics are monitored by management on a daily basis. Actual results are reported monthly against budget and any significant adverse variances are examined and remedial action taken.
- Control procedures – comprehensive procedures manuals are maintained by the Company in respect of all its main activities. In particular, there are clearly defined limits and procedures for financial expenditure, including procurement and capital expenditure, and for all draw operations.
- Monitoring system – compliance with control objectives is monitored on an ongoing basis by management. The control system is also monitored by internal audit whose work is focused on the areas of greatest risk to the Company.

The Company has procedures to ensure that appropriate arrangements are in place for employees to be able to raise, in confidence, matters of possible impropriety, with suitable subsequent follow-up action. Reporting channels have been created whereby perceived wrongdoing may be reported orally and via post, telephone and email, anonymously if preferred.

Directors' remuneration

The remuneration of the Chief Executive is subject to the approval of the Remuneration Committee of the Company. The objective is to maintain the remuneration of the Chief Executive at a level which is attractive to the individual while, at the same time, representing value for money for the Company. A proportion of the Chief Executive's remuneration is performance related and, in this way, is linked to the Company and individual objectives.

Fees for Directors are determined by the Minister for Finance.

No Director has a service contract with the Company.

During the year, the Remuneration Committee comprised Donal Connell, Niamh McGowan and Micheál Ó Muircheartaigh. Donal Connell acts as Chairman of the Committee. When necessary, non-Committee members are invited to attend. The Committee's principal responsibilities are:

- to determine, on behalf of the Board, the remuneration and other terms and conditions of employment of the Chief Executive;
- to determine, on behalf of the Board, the pay structures and terms and conditions of other senior personnel (as identified by the Chairman of the Board);
- to act, on behalf of the Board, and take all decisions related to pay and pay related matters, as the Chairman of the Board shall determine; and
- to consider any other matters considered by the Committee to be relevant to the foregoing.

The disclosures made in these financial statements relating to Directors' emoluments and pension information are those required under the Irish Companies Acts, 1963 to 2006.

The Audit Committee

During the year, the Audit Committee comprised James Hyland, Niamh McGowan and Micheál Ó Muircheartaigh. James Hyland acts as Chairman of the Committee. All the members of the Committee are non-executive Directors.

Members of the Committee bring to it a wide range of experience from senior positions in business, including that of managing partner of an accounting practice.

Under its terms of reference, the Audit Committee monitors the integrity of the Company's financial statements. The Committee is responsible for monitoring the effectiveness of the external audit process and making recommendations to the Board in relation to the appointment, re-appointment and remuneration of the external auditors. It is responsible for ensuring that an appropriate relationship between the Company and the external auditors is maintained, including reviewing non-audit services and fees. As a result of regulatory or similar requirements, it is necessary to employ the Company's external auditors for certain audit related and non-audit services. In order to maintain the independence of the external auditors, the Committee has determined policies as to what audit related and non-audit services can be provided by the Company's external auditors and the approval process related to these services. In particular, the Board considers it appropriate that independent observer and draw related services, which are the principal constituent of audit related fees paid, be performed by the external auditors. Under these policies, work of a consultancy nature will not be offered to the external auditors unless there are clear efficiencies and value added benefits to the Company while ensuring that the objectivity and independence of the external auditors is maintained. The Committee monitors the level of fees paid to the external auditors.

In 2007, the Committee discharged its responsibilities by:

- reviewing the Company's draft financial statements prior to Board approval and meeting and reviewing with the external auditors their reports thereon;
- reviewing the appropriateness of the Company's accounting policies;
- reviewing the potential impact on the Company's financial statements of significant matters;
- reviewing the resources of internal audit, approving the internal audit plans, reviewing internal audit reports and dealing with control issues raised by the internal auditors;
- overseeing a tender process for the appointment of external auditors;
- reviewing and approving the audit fee and reviewing non-audit fees payable to the Company's external auditors;
- reviewing the external auditors' plan for the audit of the Company's financial statements, confirmations of auditor independence and the proposed audit fee, and approving the terms of engagement for the audit;
- considering the adequacy of the Company's system of risk identification and assessment;
- reviewing an annual report on the Company's systems of internal control and its effectiveness, reporting to the Board on the results of the review and receiving regular updates on key risk areas of financial control.

Nomination Committee

As all the authority regarding the appointment of Directors is vested with the Minister for Finance, the matter of constituting a nomination committee is not required to be considered by the Board.

Compliance statement

The Board has developed its corporate governance policy so as to give effect to the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies issued by the Department of Finance and to apply as appropriate the relevant main and supporting principles of good governance in the 2006 Combined Code issued by the Financial Reporting Council in the UK.

The Directors confirm that the Company has been in compliance with the Code of Best Practice for the Governance of State Bodies and the relevant main and supporting principles of the 2006 Combined Code throughout the financial year under review, with the exception of a number of areas noted above where voluntary compliance with the 2006 Combined Code is not considered appropriate for the Company given the manner of appointment of Directors, the shareholding structure of the Company and existing Board procedures.

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the Company's financial statements.

1. Basis of Accounting

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention in accordance with applicable law and Irish Generally Accepted Accounting Practice which includes compliance with the financial reporting standards of the UK Accounting Standards Board as promulgated by The Institute of Chartered Accountants in Ireland.

2. Turnover

Turnover from the sale of National Lottery tickets is recognised as the tickets are sold, with adjustments being made for scratchcard ticket stocks held by agents and for Lotto/Lotto Plus/Lotto 5-4-3-2-1/Euromillions/Euromillions Plus multi draw tickets / advance tickets. Phone Play turnover comprises a portfolio of games where sales are recognised on a draw by draw basis.

All turnover is derived from and originates in Ireland.

3. Prizes

The prize structure complies with the requirements of Section 4(2) of the National Lottery Act, 1986 whereby, taking one year with another, not less than 40% of the total monies received by the Company in respect of the sale of National Lottery tickets shall be distributed in prizes. Prizes are provided for as revenue is recognised on the basis of the games particular prize structure and any difference between the total amount provided and the amounts actually distributed is included in Creditors in the balance sheet.

4. Advertising and Promotional Expenditure

Advertising and promotional expenditure is written off in full in the year in which the costs are incurred.

5. Leased Assets – Operating

Operating lease rentals are charged to the Profit and Loss Account on a straight line basis over the lease term.

6. Taxation

The Company is exempt from Corporation Tax under Section 220 Taxes Consolidation Act, 1997.

7. Fixed Assets – Tangible Assets

Tangible assets are shown as having no book value, as the total cost thereof to the Company is reimbursed out of the National Lottery Fund.

Accordingly, no depreciation is provided.

Under Section 17(1) (a) of the National Lottery Act, 1986, the Company holds these assets in trust for the State.

1. Bunús na Cuntasaíochta

2. Láimhdeachas

Aithnítear an láimhdeachas ó dhíolachán thicéid an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta de réir mar a dhíoltar na ticéid agus déantar coigeartuithe don stoc ticéad do na tob-chluichí a choinníonn na gníomhairí agus do thicéid/réamh-thicéid-ilchrannchuir Lotto/Lotto Plus/Lotto 5-4-3-2-1/EuroMillions/EuroMillions Plus. Is éard atá i láimhdeachas Phone Play ná punann chluichí agus aithnítear an díolachán ó chrannchur go crannchur.

As Éirinn a thagann agus is in Éirinn a fhaightear an láimhdeachas uile.

3. Duaiseanna

Tá an duais-struchtúr ag teacht le forálacha Alt 4(2) den Acht um Chrannchur Náisiúnta 1986. Faoi na forálacha seo, agus bliain amháin á ghlacadh le bliain eile, dáilfear mar dhuaiseanna suim nach lú ná 40% den airgead iomlán a fuair an Comhlacht mar thoradh ar dhíolachán thicéid an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta. Déantar soláthar do na duaiseanna de réir mar a aithnítear an t-ioncam agus léirítear i measc na gCreidiúnaithe ar an gClár Comhardaithe cibé difríocht a bhíonn idir an tsuim iomlán a sholáthraítear agus na suimeanna a dháiltear.

4. Caiteachas ar Fhógraíocht is ar Chur Chun Cinn

Díscriobhtar iomlán an chaiteachais ar fhógraíocht is ar chur chun cinn sa bhliain ina tharraingítear na costais.

5. Sócmhainní ar léasanna oibriúcháin

Gearrtar costas chíosanna ar léasanna oibriúcháin ar an gCuntas Brabúis agus Cailteanais ar bhonn mhéid chothroim thar tréimhse an léasa.

6. Cánachas

Tá díolúine ag an gComhlacht ó Cháin Chorparáide faoi Alt 220 den Acht Comhdhlúite Cánacha 1997.

7. Sócmhainní Seasta – Sócmhainní Inláimhsithe

Ní léirítear aon leabharluach a bheith ag sócmhainní inláimhsithe ón uair go n-aisíoctar a gcostas iomlán leis an gComhlacht as Ciste an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta.

Dá réir, ní thagann aon mhuirear dímeasa i gceist.

I gcás na sócmhainní seo, feidhmíonn an Comhlacht mar iontaobhaí thar ceann an Stáit, faoi Alt 17(1) (a) d'Acht um Chrannchur Náisiúnta 1986.

8. Fixed Assets - Financial Assets

Financial fixed assets are shown at cost less provisions for impairments in value. Income from financial fixed assets is recognised in the profit and loss account in the year in which it is receivable.

9. Stocks

Stocks comprise scratchcard ticket stocks and are valued at cost. Cost includes import duties, V.A.T. and transport costs. All unusable and obsolete stock is written off.

10. Foreign Currencies

Transactions denominated in foreign currencies are translated into Euro and recorded at the rate of exchange ruling at the date of the transaction. Monetary liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated into Euro at the rate of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date or at forward purchase contract rates where such contracts exist. All exchange differences are dealt with in the profit and loss account.

11. Pensions

The Company provides pensions to staff under multi-employer defined benefit superannuation schemes which are administered by the Company's parent, An Post, and a defined contribution scheme. In relation to the defined contribution scheme, contributions are accrued and recognised in operating profit or loss in the period in which they are earned by the relevant staff.

The Company is unable to identify its share of the underlying assets and liabilities in the defined benefit schemes on a consistent and reasonable basis. Because of this, as permitted by FRS 17, the defined benefit schemes are accounted for by the Company as if the schemes were defined contribution schemes.

8. Sócmhainní Seasta – Sócmhainní Airgeadais

Déileáiltear le gach difríocht malairte sa chuntas brabúis agus cailteanais.

11. Pinsin

Soláthraíonn an Comhlacht pinsin don fhoireann trí scéimeanna aoisliúntais ilfhostóra le sochar réamh-shainithe a riarann An Post, máthair-chuideachta an Chomhlachta, agus trí scéim ranníocach réamh-shainithe. 16. Pensions

The pension entitlements of staff arise under a number of An Post externally funded defined benefit and defined contribution pension schemes, the assets of which are vested in independent trustees appointed by An Post for the sole benefit of employees and their dependants.

An Post operates multi-employer defined benefit schemes and the Company is unable to identify its share of the underlying assets and liabilities in the schemes on a consistent and reasonable basis. Because of this, as permitted by FRS17, the schemes have been accounted for by the Company as if the schemes were defined contribution schemes.

The valuations of the An Post defined benefit schemes used for the purposes of the FRS17 disclosures have been based on the previous actuarial valuations carried out at 1 January, 2005, updated by the independent actuaries in accordance with FRS17 to assess the schemes' liabilities at 31 December, 2006. The schemes' assets were stated at their market value at that date. The net pension liabilities of the pension schemes at 31 December, 2006, the most recently available information, amounted to €180 million (31 December, 2005: €294 million). At 31 December, 2006, An Post had 8,140 permanent employees not including the 78 staff of An Post National Lottery Company.

The pension costs of the An Post defined benefit schemes are assessed in accordance with the advice of an independent professionally qualified actuary. The most recent actuarial valuations were carried out at 1 January, 2005, using the attained age method and disclosed that the assets of the schemes at that date were sufficient to cover more than 99.9% of the accrued liabilities after allowing for expected future increases in pensionable remuneration.

The principal actuarial assumption was that, over the long term, the annual rate of return on investments would be 2% higher than the annual increase in pensionable remuneration.

Contributions to the defined benefit schemes were at a rate of 14.4% (2006: 14.4%) of pensionable remuneration.

The actuarial valuations are not available for public inspection but the results of the valuations have been advised to members of the schemes.

Employer contributions to the defined contribution scheme are at rates varying between 5% and 9% of pensionable remuneration.

The total pension cost in respect of the Company for the year ended 31 December, 2007 was €753,000 (2006: €1,173,000), which included, in respect of 2006, costs associated with organisational restructuring of the Company.

An amount of €20,000 is included in accruals (2006: €4,000) representing contributions payable to An Post with respect to the pension schemes at 31 December, 2007.

19. Group Membership and Controlling Party

Grúp-chomhaltas agus Páirtí Urláimhis

The Company is a subsidiary undertaking of An Post which holds 80% of the issued share capital.

The sole activity of the Company is the operation of the National Lottery under Licence from the Minister for Finance in accordance with the provisions of the National Lottery Act, 1986. The Licence expires on 31 December, 2010.

The surplus generated each year is entirely attributable to the National Lottery Fund and, accordingly, the results of the Company are not consolidated within the An Post Group.

The Company was managed and controlled throughout the year by the Directors on behalf of An Post and the ultimate controlling party, the Minister for Finance.

20. Related Party Disclosures

Faisnéisithe Pháirtí Ghaolmhaire

In addition to the secondment of staff working in the Company, undertakings in the An Post Group provide the Company with management and delivery services. Such services are carried out on an arm's length basis or, where appropriate, in accordance with the terms of the Licence granted by the Minister for Finance to the Company to operate the National Lottery. An Post also provides agency services to the Company whereby An Post makes sales and pays prizes on behalf of the Company in accordance with the standard terms and conditions and remuneration structure common to all of the Company's agents.

Excluding staff costs (Note 6) and including the Management Fee, expenses for the year in respect of services provided by An Post Group undertakings to the Company amounted to €5,586,000 (2006: €5,363,000).

Amounts due to An Post are set out in Note 12 of the accounts.

The Company's parent, An Post, has agreed to guarantee the performance by the Company of its obligations under the Licence for the holding of the National Lottery granted by the Minister for Finance. An Post has provided the guarantee, the maximum liability of which amounts to €10 million, for the duration of the Licence.
