CHAIRMAN'S STATEMENT RÁITEAS AN CHATHAOIRLIGH



During 2009 we successfully raised €263.5 million for good causes throughout Ireland, a similar level to that raised in the previous year. This brings the overall level of funds raised since the launch of the National Lottery to over €3.4 billion – a significant amount of money by any standard. This investment in community and individual projects all over the country has made a measurable difference and demonstrates the value of Ireland's National Lottery.

Le linn 2009 d'éirigh linn €263.5 milliún a ghnóthú do dhea-chúiseanna ar fud na hÉireann – figiúr a bhí ag teacht le leibhéal na bliana seo caite. Fágann sé seo méid na gcistí a cnuasaíodh ó seoladh an Crannchuir Náisiúnta go dtí os cionn €3.4 billiún – suim nach beag de réir caighdeáin ar bith. Rinne an t-infheistiú seo i dtionscadail phobail agus aonair ar fud na tíre uile difríocht shuntasach agus léiríonn sé luach Chrannchuir Náisiúnta na hÉireann.

Following two exceptional years of growth, I am pleased to report a very satisfactory performance for the year with overall sales of €815.1 million compared to €840.1 million in 2008. This represents a slight drop of 3% in a challenging economic environment. Over the last three years National Lottery sales have increased by 20%.

Throughout 2009, we implemented a programme of innovative game developments designed to keep the National Lottery's portfolio of games exciting and relevant to players. This included the launch of Play Online, our internet games offering, and the introduction of our first daily game, 'All or Nothing'. We also launched an Irish version of the popular 'Deal or No Deal' TV Gameshow, expanded our Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 game and implemented an exciting range of prize promotions.

Performance

In each of the previous two years, record level Lotto jackpots yielded higher than expected Lotto revenues. In 2009, Lotto sales were as expected at €336.0 million compared to €381.4 million in the previous year whilst sales of Lotto Plus were €97.5 million. Within this category, Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 performed well following the addition of games based on our Lotto Plus draws in September and sales for this game increased to €11.2 million for the year.

The EuroMillions game benefitted from the excitement around Ireland's second highest ever win of €29 million resulting in sales of €105.7 million in 2009. The related EuroMillions Plus game enjoyed a 3.8% rise in sales increasing to €34.4 million from €33.2 million in 2008. 65% of all EuroMillions players now play the Plus game.

Our Monday Million draw game, launched in September 2008, became a favourite with players during 2009 achieving sales of €25.4 million. Meanwhile, the successful Millionaire Raffle game expanded and achieved overall sales of €23.5 million in the course of the year. Our TellyBingo game also performed well with a 2.4% increase in sales to €14.3 million.

I ndiaidh tréimhse dhá bhliana ina raibh fás eisceachtúil, is cúis áthais dom feidhmíocht an-sásúil a thuairisciú agus díolachán de €815.1 milliún bainte amach i gcomparáid le €840.1 milliún i 2008. Is ionann é seo agus titim de 3% i dtimpeallacht eacnamaíoch dhúshlánach. Le trí bliana anuas bhí méadú de 20% ar dhíolachán an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta.

Le linn 2009, d'fheidhmíomar clár forbartha de chluichí nuálaíocha a raibh mar aidhm leo punann cluichí an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta a choinneáil spreagúil agus spéisiúil do na himreoirí. San áireamh anseo bhí eisiúint Play Online, ár gcluiche nua idirlín, agus seoladh ár gcéad chluiche laethúil, 'All or Nothing'. Thairis sin, sheolamar leagan Éireannach den seó-chluiche móréilimh, 'Deal or No Deal', d'fhorbraíomar ár gcluiche Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 agus chuireamar i bhfeidhm raon de phromóisín duaise.

Feidhmíocht

I ngach ceann den dá bhliain dheiridh, bhí torthaí níos airde mar a raibh súil leo mar thoradh ar photaí óir ard-leibhéil Lotto. I 2009, bhíodhas ag súil le díolachán de €336.0 milliún ar Lotto, mar a rabhthas ag súil leis, i gcomparáid le €381.4 milliún an bhliain roimhe sin, an fhad is a bhí díolachán de €97.5 milliún ar Lotto Plus. Taobh istigh den chatagóir seo d'fheidhmigh Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 go maith tar éis dúinn cluichí a chur leis mí Mheán Fómhair a bhí bunaithe ar ár gcrannchuir Lotto Plus agus bhí méadú ar dhíolachán an chluiche go dtí €11.2 milliún sa bhliain.

Chuaigh an charabuaic a d'eascair as an dara bua ba mhó riamh ag Éirinn in EuroMillions – duais de €29 milliún - chun tairbhe an chluiche agus baineadh amach díolachán de €105.7 milliún i 2009. Bhí méadú de 3.8% ar dhíolachán an chluiche ghaolmhair, EuroMillions Plus, agus baineadh amach díolachán de €34.4 milliún, méadú ó €33.2 milliún i 2008. Imríonn 65% d'imreoirí uile EuroMillions an chluiche Plus anois.

Bhí ár gcluiche crannchuir, Monday Million, a seoladh mí Mheán Fómhair 2008 ar cheann de roghanna na n-imreoirí le linn 2009 agus baineadh amach díolachán de €25.4 milliún. Ag an am céanna méadaíodh an chluiche rathúil, Millionaire Raffle, agus baineadh amach díolachán de €23.5 milliún le linn na bliana. D'éirigh go maith freisin lenár gcluiche, TellyBingo, agus bhí méadú 2.4% ar an díolachán go dtí €14.3 milliún.

Scratch Cards continue to be an important part of our business, representing 20% of overall turnover with sales of €163.8 million. In 2009, we were pleased to collaborate with TV3 to bring the internationally popular 'Deal or no Deal' game to Irish television screens and give our players another exciting way to win substantial prizes.

Other new game launches in 2009 included All or Nothing, our first daily game. Launched in October, this game generated sales of €3.4 million in just over two months.

In addition to raising funds for good causes, the National Lottery also returns significant amounts of money to the community through its prize fund. In 2009, total prizes amounted to €438.3 million across the different game categories. Together with the funds generated for good causes, this represents an overall return of 86.1% of sales to our players and the Irish community.

Operations

During the year, there was an increase in business activity, including the introduction of the new daily draw and an expanded number of Millionaire Raffle draws. Total operating expenses for 2009 were €113.3 million or 13.9% of sales, down from 14% in the previous year. This figure included agents' commission of €50.9 million, down from €52.3 million in 2008, reflecting the slightly lower level of sales. Other costs of sales were reduced by €2.7 million to €39.6 million as a result of greater operating efficiencies particularly in the area of technical support. At €19.7 million, our administrative costs were 2.4% of sales.

Throughout the year, our regulator, the Minister of Finance, Brian Lenihan TD, and his department provided ongoing guidance and support, as did our main shareholder, An Post. This was much appreciated by the Board and management of the National Lottery.

As Chairman I was ably assisted in my role by the expertise of my Board colleagues. I would like to thank them for their support. The management and staff of the National Lottery also deserve recognition for delivering very satisfactory results during a very busy and challenging year.

This time last year, we were unsure as to how the economic uncertainty would affect the National Lottery's performance. We now know that with determination, imagination and hard work we can sustain our business and continue to generate much needed funds for good causes. We look forward to further developing Ireland's National Lottery, particularly our growing internet capability, while continuing to successfully manage the business and contribute to Irish society.

I 2009 bhí áthas orainn dul i bpáirtíocht le TV3 chun an cluiche, 'Deal or no Deal', a bhfuil éileamh air go hidimáisiúnta, a chur ar scáileáin teilifíse na hÉireann agus deis shuathinseach bhreise a thabhairt d'ár n-imreoirí chun duaiseanna substaintiúla a bhuanach.

I measc na gcluichí nua eile a seoladh i 2009 bhí All or Nothing, ár gcéad chluiche laethúil. Seoladh é mí Dheireadh Fómhair agus ghin sé díolachán de €3.4 milliún i mbeagán breis is dhá mhí.

Anuas ar airgead a chnuasach do dhea-chúiseanna, cuireann an Crannchur Náisiúnta suimeanna substaintiúla airgid ar ais sa phobal trína duais-chiste. I 2009, bronnadh €438.3 milliún de dhuaisanna ar fad thar na catagóirí éagsúla cluichí. Anuas ar na cistí a gineadh do dhea chúiseanna, is ionann seo agus 86.1% den díolachán a thabhairt thar n-ais d'ár n-imreoirí agus do mhuintir na hÉireann.

Oibríochtaí

Le linn na bliana bhí méadú ar ghníomhaíocht ghnó, seoladh chrannchur nua laethúil agus méadú ar líon na gcrannchur, Millionaire Raffle, san áireamh. B'ionann na costais iomlána oibríochta do 2009 agus €113.3 milliún nó 13.9% den díolachán – laghdú ó 14% an bhliain roimhe sin. Áirítear san fhigiúr seo €50.9 milliún ar choimisiún na ngníomhairí – laghdú ó €52.3 milliún i 2008 – rud a léiríonn an titim bheag ar dhíolachán. Laghdaíodh na costais eile de €2.7 milliún go dtí €39.6 milliún mar thoradh ar éifeachtacht bhreise oibríochta, go háirithe i réimse na tacaíochta teicniúla. B'ionann ár gcostais riaracháin de €19.7 milliún agus 2.4% de díolachán.

Le linn na bliana, chuir ár rialálaí, an tAire Airgeadais, Brian Ó Luineacháin TD, agus a roinn comhairle agus tacaíocht leanúnach ar fáil dúinn – rud a rinne ár bpríomh-scairshealbhóir, An Post, fosta. Ba mhór é seo ag Bord agus ag bainistíocht an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta.

Bhí saineolas mo chomhghleacaithe ar an mBord ina thaca domsa mar Chathaoirleach. Ba mhaith liom mo bhuíochas a ghabháil leo as a dtacaíocht. Tá aitheantas ag dul do bhainistíocht agus d'fhoireann an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta as torthaí an-sásúla a bhaint amach i mbliain a bhí gnóthach agus dúshlánach.

Taca an ama seo anuraidh ní raibh a fhios againn cén éifeacht a bheadh ag an éiginnteacht eacnamaíoch ar fheidhmíocht an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta. Is eol dúinn anois go dtig linn le diongbháilteacht, le samhlaíocht agus le cruasaothar ár ngnó a iompar agus leanúint orainn ag giniúint airgid, a bhfuil géarghá leis, do dhea chúiseanna. Táimid ag súil le Crannchur Náisiúnta na hÉireann a fhorbairt, go háirithe trínár n-acmhainn idirlín, agus leanúint orainn ag am céanna de bheith ag bainistiú an ghnó agus ag tacú leis an sochaí in Éirinn.

REVIEW OF OPERATIONS ATHBHREITHNIÚ OIBRÍOCHTA



After exceptionally good years in 2007 and 2008, the National Lottery again delivered a strong performance in 2009 and raised €263.5 million for good causes. We generated sales of €815.1 million – our second highest level of sales ever, just below the record level achieved in 2008 – in an environment where retail footfall was significantly down. This was achieved by expanding our game portfolio to create fun and excitement for players and generate funds for good causes.

Our players and prizes

PLAYERS

With 65% of all adults, or 2.2 million people, playing National Lottery games on a regular basis, our player base draws from all adult population segments.

During 2009, we continued our strategy of developing our overall mix of games in order to keep our players involved and excited by the great prizes on offer and the fun of playing.

PRIZES

Prizes are the key factor in the successful operation of Ireland's National Lottery and in 2009 our players shared winnings of €438.3 million. That's an average of €1.2 million won every day of the year.

During the year, there were 139 jackpot winners across all our draw games, the highest of which was the Dublin winner of €29 million on the EuroMillions game. In all, 937 players won prizes over €10,000.

Our Lotto games continue to perform well

Leanann ár gCluichí Lotto de bheith ag feidhmiú go maith

Over the three years since we introduced the new enhanced Lotto game structure, sales have performed very well, with a 23% increase in our Lotto draw games. This level of growth is one of the highest in the world for an established Lotto game. The first two years, 2007 and 2008, were exceptional in terms of jackpot rollovers, with record jackpots of €18.9 million and €15.2 million respectively, so we anticipated a more normal year in 2009. The relatively low level of jackpot rollovers naturally had an impact on sales of our main Lotto draw games. Lotto sales were €336.0 million, while Lotto Plus sales were €97.5 million. This compares to €381.4 million and €109.0 million respectively in the previous year.

We were delighted to have had 22 Lotto jackpot wins throughout the year, giving an average of one jackpot win every 2.5 weeks, and generating revenue in line with expectations for the game.

The largest jackpot during the year was €14,530,193 which was won on 18 April by a lucky couple from Glenageary, Co. Dublin. This was followed by the second highest 2009 jackpot of €13,150,324 on 26 May. The winning ticket was sold in Dalkey Post Office, Co. Dublin and won by a husband and wife from the west of Ireland who bought a €4 quick pick on a visit to Dublin.

Le linn na dtrí bliana ó thugamar ár struchtúr nua de chluichí Lotto isteach bhí rath ar an díolachán agus bhí méadú 23% ar ár gcluichí crannchuir Lotto. Tá an ráta fáis seo ar cheann de na cinn is airde ar domhan do chluiche seanbhunaithe Lotto. Bhí an dá bhliain tosaigh, 2007 agus 2008, eisceachtúil i dtéarmaí tar-rolladh na bpotáí óir, le potaí óir de €18.9 milliún agus €15.2 milliún faoi seach, rud a d'fhág go rabhamar ag súil le bliain níos normálta i 2009. A very popular win was that by the KennCo syndicate when all 20 employees of that company shared €8,533,395 in early November.

To stimulate excitement amongst players, we introduced 14 special Lotto related promotions partly funded from unclaimed prizes. An extra €2 million was added to the jackpot on nine special occasions and bank holiday weekends throughout the year.

For Valentine's Day, we had a special promotion where Match 5 plus Bonus winners on Lotto and Lotto Plus games won €100,000 worth of diamonds along with their regular prizes. To celebrate Halloween, there was a 'Match 4 Win More' draw, where each Match 4 and Match 4 plus bonus winner in Lotto, Lotto Plus 1 and Lotto Plus 2 was guaranteed €200.

Special Lotto 'Double All Prizes' promotions took place for Easter, Back to School and Christmas with all prizes, apart from the jackpot, doubled for Lotto and Lotto Plus games. On two weekends in December, all Lotto, and Lotto Plus 1 and Lotto Plus 2 winners received an extra prize of a 'Deal or no Deal' Scratch Card.

Lotto players won cash prizes to the value of €168 million during 2009 and 27 individual millionaires were created. During the year, there were 26 jackpots between €5 million and €10 million and a further eight jackpots over €10 million.

Lotto Plus winners shared €46.5 million, including 29 winners of the €350,000 Lotto Plus 1 top prize and 15 winners of the €250,000 Lotto Plus 2 top prize.

The numbers game Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 was extended during the year to include the option of playing the Plus draws. Players responded well to this innovation with sales of €11.2 million achieved. The structure of this game generates a larger amount of smaller prizes with a high prize pay out level of 66%. Players won a total of €7.4 million in this game in 2009.

Sales of EuroMillions in 2009 were €105.7 million, down marginally from €109.0 million in the previous year. The related draw game, EuroMillions Plus, increased sales by 3.8% to €34.4 million as more players realised the unique benefits of this game.

Irish players won a combined total of €71.5 million from the two EuroMillions draw games, a similar level to the previous year when €72.5 million was won.

There was great excitement when an Irish winner shared the jackpot in June winning €29,430,608 and continuing the luck of the Irish in this game. This was the second highest ever Irish win and was paid from the central EuroMillions jackpot fund. The winning €6 quick pick was bought by a family syndicate of six people in Dora Kelly's Newsagents in Newcastle, Co. Dublin.

A number of EuroMillions Plus extra draws also took place throughout the year ensuring further excitement for players. These draws mainly took place around bank holiday and festive weekends. Each of these six 'Extra Draws' offered €1 million as the top prize. In cases where the top prize wasn't won, the €1 million was shared by winners at the next level.

I am pleased to report that during 2009, there were 27 lucky winners of the EuroMillions Plus top prize of €500,000, compared to 15 winners in 2008.

Sales of Scratch Cards in 2009 were €163.8 million, compared to €170.2 million in the previous year. As always, the key to success in this category was the introduction of new and exciting games for players. Alongside our continuing popular games, such as All Cash and Congratulations, 24 new games were launched during the year, including Gravy Train, Quarter Million Cash, Lovely Lolly and Sherlock Holmes. Depending on their preferences, players could choose their own personal favourites from a broad portfolio of entertaining Scratch Card games ranging in price from €1 up to €10.

All Cash Gold was the most popular single Scratch Card with individual sales of €32.8 million, representing 20% of overall Scratch Card sales.

A firm favourite with players since it was launched in 1990, Winning Streak, held its status as Europe's richest and longest running TV Gameshow with players winning €11,065,500 over 40 weeks during 2009. The biggest win was on 28 November when Sean Adair from Castlebar,

The top prize of €250,000 was won four times throughout the series. Early in the season, Sarah Morris, Ashbourne, Co. Meath and Brendan Doyle, Carrickmacross, Co. Monaghan each won the top prize. Then on two consecutive weeks in August there were two further top wins; firstly by Marita Duffy from Dundalk, Co. Louth on 15 August and again the following week by Austin Connole from Ennis, Co. Clare.

In October, 42 winners of the stub feature on the Big Money Scratch Card game travelled to New York on the trip of a lifetime with their guests and €2,500 spending money for each winner. There were 25 further holidays to the value €125,000 and 20 cars worth €315,000 won in the course of the show.

Throughout the year, our players won €104.7 million in prizes on Scratch Card games, ranging from instant wins of €2 to over €250,000 on the TV Gameshow. There were also special feature prizes on offer including shopping vouchers, hampers, Cadbury Roses chocolates, Easter eggs and free tickets.

TELLYBINGO

Sales of TellyBingo were up 2.4% from €13.9 million in 2008 to €14.3 million in the year under review as this game's popularity increased among its loyal group of players. A total of €10.2 million was won in prizes – an average prize payout level of 71%.

On 25 September, all prizes in TellyBingo were doubled as a special reward for players. An extra €50,000 was added to the TellyBingo Snowball in June and again in August.

The biggest Snowball during the year was €100,000 which was shared on 28 August by three winners from Cavan, Offaly and Tipperary. In total, there were 27 Snowball winners and 326 Full House winners during the year.

We started with the New Year's Day Millionaire Raffle draw, followed by our second Millionaire Raffle on the Easter weekend. For the summer Millionaire Raffle the top winning tickets were drawn live on TV at the 50th Rose of Tralee in August. These were limited edition games with 300,000 tickets costing €20 each available. The two top prizes in each game were €1,000,000 with lots of other great cash prizes. These included five prizes of €100,000; 45 of €10,000; 80 of €5,000; 100 of €1,000 and 300 prizes worth €500 each.

For Christmas Millionaire Raffle the game was expanded to include additional features such as early bonus draws, an additional €1million top prize and a bigger prize fund. The draw took place live on RTE TV on New Year's Eve creating three new millionaires – one in Dublin and two in Galway - and hundreds of other prize winners.

Rosanna McCarthy from Blanchardstown, Dublin was one of five lucky Christmas Millionaire Raffle players to win €100,000 in the draw on New Year's Day 2009. Rosanna celebrated her win at National Lottery offices with family.

2009 was a very busy year on the new games front. In addition to the extensions of the Plus draws to Lotto 5-4-3-2-1, we launched two completely new games: All or Nothing and Deal or No Deal.

All or Nothing, a new daily game, was launched in early October and has already gained popularity among players generating sales of €3.4 million in less than three months. The game concept is simple with players picking 12 numbers between 1 and 24. They can win €500,000 by matching all 12 numbers drawn or they can win the €500,000 jackpot amount if their selected numbers match none of the numbers drawn.

Players can also match numbers in four other prize categories to win amounts varying from €4 to €5,000. The prize pay-out level on All or Nothing is 61% and, since its launch towards the end of the year, lucky players have shared €2.1 million in prizes. Already, we have had two top winners – one who matched all 12 numbers correctly and one who matched none of the numbers. Each won €500,000. The winner of the match nothing prize bought the ticket in Lucan, Co. Dublin and it was the first time in the history of the National Lottery that we paid out a prize to someone who won a jackpot by matching none of the numbers! There were also 89 winners of the €5,000 prize to the end of 2009.

Towards the end of the year, a 20 week series of the internationally popular TV Gameshow Deal or No Deal was brought to Ireland by the National Lottery. In an innovative development, players could gain entry to the TV Gameshow exclusively through the National Lottery's Deal or No Deal Scratch Card.

Entertainer Keith Barry hosted the Irish version of the exciting TV Gameshow, under licence from Endemol. Each week, one lucky player takes on the infamous Banker for the opportunity to win up to €250,000. The highest win in 2009 was €89,000 won by Hannah O'Connor from Galway.

This game went on air on TV3 in November and continues up to March 2010. Viewership numbers were 402,000 for the first night of the new TV Gameshow on 13 November 2009.

Popular Today FM radio presenter Ian Dempsey hosted the first ever All or Nothing draw in National Lottery offices on 8 October 2009. This new daily game gives players the chance to win €500,000 if they match all or no numbers drawn.

Bliain an-ghnóthach ba ea 2009 ó thaobh cluichí de. Chomh maith leis na crannchuir Plus a chur le Lotto 5-4-3-2-1, sheolamar dhá chluiche úrnua: All or Nothing agus Deal or No Deal.

Cluiche laethúil nua é All or Nothing a seoladh go luath i mí Dheireadh Fómhair agus cheana féin tá sé tar éis imreoirí a mhealladh chuige féin agus díolachán de €3.4 milliún a ghiniúint i níos lú ná trí mhí. Coincheap simplí atá taobh thiar den chluiche agus roghnaíonn na himreoirí 12 uimhir idir 1 agus 24. Tig leo €500,000 a bhuachan tríd an 12 uimhir a tharraingítear a mheaitseáil nó tig leo an pota óir a bhuachan mura meaitseáilann a n uimhreacha aon cheann de na huimhreacha a tharraingítear.

Tig le himreoirí uimhreacha a mheaitseáil i gceithre dhuais-chatagóir eile agus suimeanna idir €4 agus €5,000 a bhuachan. Leibhéal focaíocht duaise de 61% atá ar All or Nothing agus ó seoladh é faoi dheireadh na bliana roinneadh €2.1 milliún ar imreoirí ádhúla. Cheana féin bhí beirt bhuaiteoirí barr-dhuaise againn – duine amháin a mheaitseáil gach ceann den 12 uimhir agus duine eile nár mheaitseáil aon cheann díobh. Bhuaiigh gach duine díobh €500,000. Cheannaigh buaiteoir na duaise match nothing an ticéad i Leamhcán Co. Bhaile Átha Cliath. B'in an chéad uair i stair an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta gur dhíolamar duais le duine a bhuaiigh pota óir agus gan aon uimhir dá chuid ag meaitseáil! Chomh maith leis sin, bhuaiigh 89 duine duais de €5,000 faoi dheireadh 2009.

I dtreo dheireadh na bliana thóg an Crannchur Náisiúnta sraith 20 seachtain den seó-chluiche teilifíse, Deal or No Deal, go hÉirinn – cluiche a bhfuil éileamh air go hidirnáisiúnta. Mar thoradh ar chinneadh nuálaíoch, socraíodh gur trí scríobchárta Deal or No Deal an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta amháin a fhéadfadh imreoirí fáil isteach sa seó-chluiche teilifíse.

Ba é an t oifigeach, Keith Barry, a chuir an leagan Éireannach den seó-chluiche teilifíse suaithinseach i láthair faoi cheadúnas ó Endemol. Gach seachtain tugann imreoirí ádhúil éigin dúshlán an Bhaincéara mhíchluíigh féachaint le €250,000 a bhuachan. B'í Hannah O'Connor ó Ghaillimh a bhain an duais a b'airde i 2009 - €89,000.

Tháinig an cluiche seo ar an aer ar TV3 mí na Samhna agus leanfaidh sé air go dtí mí an Mhárta 2010. Bhí an lucht féachana de 402,000 duine ann an chéad oíche den seó-chluiche nua teilifíse ar 13 Samhain 2009.



Our new **Play Online** facility broadens our player base

An Crannchur Náisiúnta á imirt ar Líne

In March 2009, the National Lottery took the strategically important step of providing players with the opportunity to play its key games online. The popular draw games and instant win games are now all available online once players complete the registration process.

Lotto, Lotto Plus and EuroMillions, together with instant win games – Blackjack, Bingo, Angels & Devils, Spin to Win and Suit Pursuit – can now be played from the comfort of players' homes.

Our online player base is growing steadily as more people become aware of the convenient option of playing National Lottery games over the internet. Since we introduced this facility, 6,000 players have generated €744,000 in revenue and we expect that this channel will be a significant source of growth in the future.

We took time to ensure that these new games were introduced in a way that is secure and appropriate for the Irish market. As with all National Lottery games, proper system facilities and security checks are in place to safeguard our players and guarantee the integrity, credibility and fairness which are the hallmarks of our business.

Managing our business

Ag Bainistiú ár nGnó

Total operating costs were reduced by €4.1 million to 13.9% of sales, despite a very busy year in terms of the extension of our games portfolio and related draw activities.

These costs included agents' commissions of €50.9 million and other costs of sales of €39.6 million. A significant portion of our costs relates to technical network facilities, and I am pleased to report that these costs were reduced by 10% to €19.7 million, or 2.4% of turnover, in 2009. Administrative costs for the year were €19.7 million, representing 2.4% of total sales.

In marketing, we continue to benefit from our fully integrated new corporate identity as the star branding symbol presents a coordinated image and, at the same time, allows the flexibility to add new games to the portfolio.

Our retail network was expanded to 3,794 agents compared to 3,675 in 2008. I would like to thank all our agents for their continued support. Throughout the year, we maintained a strong focus on increasing our in-store presence - testing new promotional initiatives such as the use of digital display screens to communicate National Lottery information. We also continued the roll out of electronic ticket checkers to all full Lotto agents. Over 2,000 ticket checkers have now been installed for the convenience and security of our players and we plan to have these handy devices in all agent stores by the end of 2010.

The introduction of a daily draw in October added a significant amount of activity across all levels of our operations, including evenings, weekends and bank holidays. Throughout 2009, we had a total of 858 individual draws and we now have 20 regular draws per week. As a result, the

I would like to thank everyone working in the National Lottery for their commitment throughout 2009. In particular, I would like to note the sudden death of our Head of Finance, Noel Browne who had worked with the National Lottery since its inception in 1987. He played an invaluable role in the development of the business and is sadly missed by his colleagues.

Given the general economic environment, it was a difficult year but hard work and creativity meant that we achieved our objectives in developing the business and delivering a significant surplus for good causes.

Since the National Lottery was launched, over €3.4 billion has been raised for good causes with 32% of all National Lottery sales funding beneficiary projects around the country. This level of funding has made a significant difference to communities, projects and individuals in the areas of Youth, Sports, Recreation & Amenities; Health & Welfare; Arts, Culture & National Heritage and the Irish Language.

During 2009, we continued to highlight the level and positive impact of funds raised. In this regard, we were pleased to demonstrate the difference that National Lottery funds make through the inclusion of a selection of the many worthwhile projects on the weekly TV Gameshows on RTE.

The Children's Sunshine Home

The Children's Sunshine Home provides care for children with life-limiting illnesses and their families, and offers end-of-life care. It also provides trained caring staff for home support, crisis care and after care. Construction on Ireland's first children's hospice, LauraLynn House, has already begun on the grounds of the Children's Sunshine Home in Leopardstown Co. Dublin. When it opens in 2011, the LauraLynn Children's Hospice will bring care and support to more children and their families.

In 2009, the Children's Sunshine Home received €128,000 in National Lottery funding towards the cost of construction of children's accommodation which will also be used for the LauraLynn Hospice.

Irish Language

An Ghaeilge

Conradh na Gaeilge

Conradh na Gaeilge promotes the Irish language in Ireland and abroad, through over 200 branches and many individual members, working with other community groups and Irish language organisations to promote language rights in every aspect of everyday life. Its national network of classes and conversation circles helps language learners across Ireland, and the organisation encourages young people to use the Irish language through their summer college road show, school workshops and events in third-level colleges.

In 2009, Conradh na Gaeilge received €236,686 towards the development of its headquarters as a centre for the Irish language through the Department of Community, Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs, which is part-funded by the National Lottery.

Paul Hession

Paul Hession is regarded as one of Ireland's most successful international track and field athletes. Paul specialises in the 200 metres sprint and set four Irish national records at 100 and 200 metres in 2007. He was a 200 metre silver medalist in the 2008 IAAF World Athletics Final and competed at the 2008 Summer Olympics in Beijing, only narrowly missing out on a place in the final. Paul is one of the many Irish athletes who receive funding and support from the High Performance Carding Scheme, administered by the Irish Sports Council and part-funded by the National Lottery.

In 2009, under this scheme, Ireland's elite athletes received €2.5 million in grant aid.

Abbey Theatre

Originally founded by W.B. Yeats and Lady Augusta Gregory, in 1925 the Abbey Theatre became the first ever state-subsidised theatre in the English speaking world. It celebrated its centenary in 2005 with an imaginative programme of work, and the National Lottery, through a specially designed sponsorship, brought 5,000 post-primary students from all over Ireland to the Abbey Theatre in Dublin.

The Abbey Theatre now receives an annual grant from the Arts Council of Ireland, which is part-funded by the National Lottery.

B'iad W.B. Yeats agus Lady Augusta Gregory a chéad-bhunaigh Amharclann na Mainistreach i 1925 agus bhí sí ar an gcéad amharclann i ndomhan an Bhéarla a fuair maoiniú stáit. Our objectives for the future

Having concentrated on extending our portfolio of games over the last number of years, our strategy for the coming years will be to promote the various benefits of these games to existing and new players.

A key area for continued development will be our internet based games where we intend to expand the number and range of games available to our players. We see this as a strong growth area in keeping with the general uptake of digital communications and expectations of today's generation of players. This should allow us to grow the overall market for our games.

In the retail sector, digital screens displaying game information will be extended to more agents in the next two years. We are also working with our EuroMillions partners to enhance this game and we will be involved in the development of plans for Ireland's inclusion in a World Lottery game which we expect will be launched in 2012.


In summary, we aim to bring our National Lottery games to a new generation of players and, in doing so, build on the €3.4 billion raised for good causes to date.

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REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS

The Directors have pleasure in submitting their twenty third annual report, together with the audited financial statements of the Company, for the year ended 31 December, 2009, in fulfilment of their obligations under the Companies Acts, 1963 to 2009.

1. The Company

The Company carries on the business of operating the National Lottery under Licence from the Minister for Finance in accordance with the provisions of the National Lottery Act, 1986.

80% of the issued share capital is held by An Post and 20% is held by the Minister for Finance.

2. Results for the Year

The results for the year are set out on page 46.

3. Business Review

The information required by Section 13 of the Companies (Amendment) Act, 1986, on the development of the business and important events, is included in the Chairman's Statement and Review of Operations on pages 2 to 25.

As described therein, the Company had a substantial surplus of €264m in 2009 (2008: €268m) to the benefit of the Beneficiary Fund. This resulted from sales of €815m in 2009 (2008: €840m). The decline in sales reflects the more normal out-turn on the Lotto jackpot rollover sequence as compared to the previous year where rollover sequence patterns exceeded expectations. In addition sales in 2009 were also adversely impacted by the deterioration in the Irish economy. The Company benefited from a full year's revenue from Monday Million, an expanded number of Raffles and the introduction of a new daily game 'All or Nothing'.

In monitoring the Company's performance, the Directors and management have regard to a range of key performance indicators (KPIs).

The above KPIs are within the terms of the Licence to operate the National Lottery.

The key risks and uncertainties facing the future development of the Company include the retention of the Company's licence to operate the National Lottery, the Company's significant reliance upon its IT infrastructure and retailer operations, the impact of general economic factors on the Company and the introduction of new games and channels. The Directors have developed a range of strategies to address these and other risks faced by the Company. The Corporate Governance Statement on page 31 sets out the Company's policies and approach to risks and the related internal control procedures and responsibilities.

4. Directors, Secretary and their interests

The Directors of the Company are appointed by the Minister for Finance for a fixed term, usually three years, and their conditions of appointment and fees are set out in writing.

The terms of office of Dermot Griffin and Micheál Ó Muircheartaigh expired on 5 November 2009, and they were re-appointed from that date.

The Directors and Secretary who held office at 31 December 2009 had no interest in the shares in, or debentures of, the Company or any Group Company.

5. Employees

The Company and An Post, which provides seconded staff to the Company, are equal opportunities employers. All applications for employment are given full and fair consideration, due regard being given to the aptitude and ability of the individual and the requirements of the position concerned.

All persons are treated on equal terms as regards training, career development and promotion.

The well-being of staff working in the Company is safeguarded through the strict adherence to health and safety standards. The Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act, 2005 imposes certain requirements in respect of staff and the Company has taken the necessary action to ensure compliance with the Act, including the adoption of a Safety Statement.

6. Corporate Governance

Maintaining high standards of corporate governance continues to be a priority of the Directors of An Post National Lottery Company. The Board has developed its corporate governance policy so as to give effect to the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies issued by the Department of Finance and to apply as appropriate the relevant main and supporting principles of good governance in the 2006 Combined Code issued by the Financial Reporting Council in the UK. While the provisions of the Combined Code are of direct relevance only to listed companies, the Board feels that their application, where appropriate, assists the Company in its compliance with best corporate governance practice.

The Directors are accountable to the shareholders for good corporate governance and this report addresses how the relevant main and supporting principles of the Code of Best Practice for the Governance of State Bodies and the 2006 Combined Code have been applied within An Post National Lottery Company.

Tháinig tréimhsí oifige Dermot Griffin agus Mhichíl Uí Mhuircheartaigh chun críche ar 5 Samhain 2009 agus athcheapadh iad le feidhm ón dáta sin.

Ní raibh leas tairbhiúil, scaireanna sa Chomhlacht ná bintíúir a bhain leis nó le haon Ghrúp Chuideachta ag na Stiúrthóirí ná ag an Rúnaí a bhí in oifig ar 31 Nollaig 2009.

5. Fostaithe

Fostóirí comhdheise iad an Comhlacht agus An Post, a sholáthraíonn foireann ar shealscarúint don Chomhlacht. Cuirtear gach iarratas ar fhostaíocht san áireamh go hiomlán agus go cothrom agus tugtar aird chuí ar mhianach agus ar chumas an duine agus ar riachtanais an phoist atá i gceist.

Caitear le gach duine ar bhonn cothrom chomh fada is a bhaineann sé le hoiliúint, le forbairt gairme agus le hardú céime a thabhairt.

Déantar cúram de dhea-bhail na foirne, atá ag obair leis an gComhlacht trí chloí go docht le caighdeáin shábháilteachta agus sláinte. Leagann An tAcht um Shábháilteacht, Sláinte agus Leas ag an Obair, 2005, dualgais áirithe i leith na foirne agus tá na céimeanna riachtanacha glactha ag an gComhlacht chun déanamh de réir an Achta. Áirítear orthusan glacadh le Ráiteas Sábháilteachta.

6. Rialachas Corparáide

Tosaíocht é ag Stiúrthóirí Chomhlacht Chrannchuir Náisiúnta an Phoist ardchaighdeán rialachais corparáide a choinneáil. D'fhorbair an Bord a pholasáil rialachas corparáide le go mbeadh feidhm ag an gCód Sár-chleachtas um Rialachas Chomhlachtaí Stáit a d'éisigh an Roinn Airgeadais agus chun feidhm a thabhairt nuair is cuí do phríomhphrionsabail agus do phrionsabail thacaíochta ábhartha um dhea-rialachas atá sa Chomhchód a d'éisigh an Financial Reporting Council sa Ríocht Aontaithe i 2006. Siúd is go mbaineann forálacha an Chomhchóid go díreach le cuideachtaí liostáilte amháin, braitheann an Bord go gcuidíonn a bhfeidhmíú mar is cuí leis an gComhlacht chun sár chleachtas rialachais corparáide a chomhlíonadh.

Tá na Stiúrthóirí freagrach do na scairshealbhóirí as dearialachas corparáide agus pléann an tuarascáil seo leis an tsliú inar cuireadh i bhfeidhm na príomhphrionsabail agus na prionsabail thacaíochta ábhartha atá le fáil sa Chód Sár-chleachtas um Rialachas Chomhlachtaí Stáit agus i gComhchód 2006 i gcás Chomhlacht Chrannchuir Náisiúnta an Phoist.

The Board

The Company is controlled through its Board of Directors. The Board's main roles are to oversee the operation of the Company, to provide leadership to the Company, to approve the Company's strategic objectives and to ensure that the necessary financial and other resources are made available to enable them to meet those objectives. The Board, which meets monthly during the year, has a schedule of matters reserved for its approval.

The specific responsibilities reserved to the Board include: setting Company strategy and approving an annual budget and medium-term projections; reviewing operational and financial performance; approving major capital expenditure; ensuring compliance with the terms of the licence to operate the National Lottery; reviewing the Company's systems of financial control and risk management; ensuring that appropriate management development and succession plans are in place; reviewing the environmental, health and safety performance of the Company; approving the appointment of the Company Secretary; and ensuring that a satisfactory dialogue takes place with shareholders.

The Board has delegated the following responsibilities to management: the development and recommendation of strategic plans for consideration by the Board that reflect the longer-term objectives and priorities established by the Board; implementation of the strategies and policies of the Company as determined by the Board; monitoring of the operating and financial results against plans and budgets; development of controls over the operation of draws; prioritising the allocation of technical and human resources; and developing and implementing risk management systems.

The roles of the Chairman and Chief Executive

The Chairman leads the Board in the determination of its strategy and in the achievement of its objectives. The Chairman is responsible for organising the business of the Board, ensuring its effectiveness and setting its agenda. The Chairman facilitates the effective contribution of non-executive Directors and constructive relations between the executive Director and non-executive Directors, ensures that Directors receive accurate, timely and clear information and manages effective communication with shareholders.

The Chief Executive has direct charge of the Company on a day to day basis and is accountable to the Board for the financial and operational performance of the Company.

Senior Independent Director

The Board has considered the matter of designating a recognised senior member other than the Chairman to whom concerns can be conveyed and, in view of the manner of appointment of Directors, the shareholding structure and existing Board procedures, has concluded it is not necessary in the circumstances.

An Bord

Rialaítear an Chomhlacht trína Bhord Stiúrtha. Is iad príomhróil an Bhoird maoirseacht a dhéanamh ar oibríochtaí an Chomhlachta, cinnireacht a sholáthar don Chomhlacht, cuspóirí straitéiseacha an Chomhlachta a fhaomhadh agus deimhin a dhéanamh de go gcuirtear ar fáil na hacmhainní riachtanacha airgeadais agus eile chun gur féidir leo na cuspóirí sin a bhaint amach. Uair sa mhí a thagann an Bord le chéile le linn na bliana. Tá sceideal ábhar atá forchoimeáda le faomhadh ag an mBord.

I measc na sainfhreagrachtaí atá forchoimeáda don Bhord tá: straitéis an Chomhlachta a cheapadh agus an buiséad bliantúil agus na réamh-mheastacháin mheántéarmacha a fhaomhadh; feidhmiú oibríoch agus airgeadais a athbhreithniú; mórchaiteachas caipitil a fhaomhadh; deimhin a dhéanamh de go bhfuil téarmaí an cheadúnais chun an Crannchuir Náisiúnta a reáchtáil á gcomhlíonadh; córais an Chomhlachta um rialú airgeadais agus bainistiú riosca a athbhreithniú; deimhin a dhéanamh de go bhfuil pleananna cuí i bhfeidhm chun forbairt agus comharbaíocht na bainistíochta a chinntiú; feidhmiú an Chomhlachta ó thaobh na timpeallachta agus cúrsaí sláinte is sábháilteachta de a athbhreithniú; ceapadh Rúnaí an Chomhlachta a fhaomhadh; deimhin a dhéanamh de go mbíonn idirphlé sásúil ann leis na scairshealbhóirí.

Tá na freagrachtaí seo a leanas tarmilgthe ag an mBord don bhainistíocht: pleananna straitéiseacha, a bheadh ag teacht le cuspóirí agus le tosaíochtaí fadtéarmacha an Bhoird, a cheapadh agus a mholadh don Bhord le scrúdú; straitéisí agus polasaithe an Chomhlachta, mar atá sonraithe ag an mBord, a fheidhmiú; faireachán a dhéanamh ar thorthaí oibríochta agus airgeadais i gcomparáid le pleananna agus le buiséid; córais rialaithe a fhorbairt do reáchtáil na gcrannchuir; tosaíochtaí a cheapadh do chionroinnt acmhainní daonna is teicniúla; agus córais bainistíochta riosca a cheapadh is a chur i bhfeidhm.

Róil an Cathaoirleach agus an Phríomhfheidhmeannaigh

Is é *An Cathaoirleach* a threoraíonn an Bord maidir le cinneadh polasaí agus le baint amach a chuid cuspóirí. Is é an Cathaoirleach atá freagrach as gnó an Bhoird a eagrú, as a éifeacht a chinntiú agus as an clár gnó a shocrú. Éascaíonn an Cathaoirleach rannpháirtíocht éifeachtach na Stiúrthóirí neamh-fheidhmiúcháin agus deachaidreamh idir iad agus an Stiúrthóir feidhmiúcháin agus cinntíonn sé go bhfaigheann na Stiúrthóirí eolas cruinn, tráthúil agus soiléir. Bainistíonn sé freisin cumarsáid éifeachtach leis na scairshealbhóirí.

Is ag an *bPríomhfheidhmeannach* atá údarás díreach ar an gComhlacht ó lá go chéile agus tá sé freagrach don Bhord as feidhmiú oibríoch agus airgeadais an Chomhlachta.

Stiúrthóir Sinsearach Neamhspleách

Scrúdaigh an Bord an fhéidearthacht go gceapfaí comhalta sinsearach inaitheanta, seachas an Cathaoirleach, mar dhuine go bhféadfaí ábhair inní a chur faoina bhráid agus i ngeall ar an tslí ina gceaptar Stiúrthóirí, struchtúr an scairchaipitil agus gnáthaimh reatha an Bhoird, shocraigh an Bord nach mbeadh a leithéid de shocrú riachtanach faoi na cúinsí sin.

Directors and Directors' independence

The Board currently comprises the Chairman, five non-executive Directors and the Chief Executive. The names of the Directors together with their biographical details are set out on pages 26 and 27. The positions of Chairman and Chief Executive are held by different persons. Given its status as a State Company, its shareholding structure and the appointment of the Directors by the Minister, the Board believes that the criteria normally used by the board of a listed Company in considering the independence of its Directors do not apply to the Company. The Board includes independent non-executive Directors who constructively challenge and help develop proposals on strategy, bring strong independent judgement, knowledge, and experience to the Board's deliberations. The independent Directors are of sufficient calibre and number that their views carry significant weight in the Board's decision making.

The 2006 Combined Code requires the Chairman to hold meetings with the non-executive Directors without the executive Director being present. The Board has formal procedures in place in this regard.

Directors have the right to ensure that any concerns they have, which cannot be resolved, about the running of the Company or a proposed action, are recorded in the Board minutes. In addition, upon resignation, a non-executive Director will be asked to provide a written statement to the Chairman, for circulation to the Board, if they have any such concerns.

The Directors are given access to independent professional advice at the Company's expense, when the Directors deem it is necessary in order for them to carry out their responsibilities.

All of the non-executive Directors are independent of management. The Board includes both the chief executive of the Company's parent company, An Post, as Chairman and James Hyland, a non-executive director of An Post. The Board considers all other non-executive Directors to be independent on the basis of the following:

- they have not been an employee of the Company within the last five years;
- they have no material business relationship with the Company, nor have they had any within the last three years;
- they receive no remuneration other than through Director's fees;
- they have no close family ties with any of the Company's advisers, Directors or senior employees; and
- they hold no cross-directorships and have no significant links with other Directors through involvement in other companies or bodies.

Stiúrthóirí agus Neamhspleáchas na Stiúrthóirí

San am i láthair, is iad comhaltaí an Bhoird an Cathaoirleach, cúigear Stiúrthóirí neamh fheidhmiúcháin agus an Príomhfheidhmeannach. Tá ainmneacha na Stiúrthóirí mar aon lena lena sonraí beathaisnéise leagtha amach ar leathanaigh 26 agus 27. Daoine difriúla atá i bpost an Chathaoirligh agus i bpost an Phríomhfheidhmeannaigh. Nuair a chuirtear san áireamh gur comhlacht Stáit atá i gceist, struchtúr an scairchaipitil agus gurb é an tAire a cheapann na Stiúrthóirí, measann an Bord nach dtagann na gnáth-chritéir, a d'úsáidfeadh stiúrthóirí chuideachta liostáilte chun neamhspleáchas a Stiúrthóirí a mheas, i bhfeidhm sa chás seo. Áirítear ar an mBord Stiúrthóirí neamh-feidhmiúcháin neamhspleácha a cheistíonn ar bhealach dearfach moltaí faoi chúrsaí straitéise agus a chabhraíonn le hiad a fhorbairt. Thairis sin, tugann siad breithiúnas láidir, neamhspleách, maille le heolas agus taithí agus ceisteanna á scrúdú ag an mBord. Tá na Stiúrthóirí neamhspleácha líonmhar a dhóthain agus de chaighdeán sách ard le go mbeadh tionchar nach beag ag a dtuairimí ar chinntí an Bhoird.

Faoi Chomhchód 2006 tá dualgas ar an gCathaoirleach cruinnithe a bheith aige leis na Stiúrthóirí neamh-feidhmiúcháin gan an Stiúrthóir feidhmiúcháin a bheith i láthair. Tá gnáthaimh fhoirmeálta chuige seo i bhfeidhm ag an mBord.

Tá sé de cheart ag Stiúrthóirí deimhin a dhéanamh de go gcláraítear i miontuairiscí an Bhoird aon ábhar inní gan réiteach atá acu faoi réachtáil an Chomhlachta nó faoi bheart atá molta. De bhreis air sin, iarrfar ar aon Stiúrthóir neamh-feidhmiúcháin a éiríonn as oifig, ráiteas i scríbhinn a thabhairt don Chathaoirleach, le cur thart ar an mBord, má tá aon ábhar inní aige.

Cuirtear comhairle neamhspleách phroifisiúnta ar fáil do na Stiúrthóirí ar chostas an Chomhlachta má shíleann na Stiúrthóirí go bhfuil gá lena leithéid le go bhfeadfaidís a gcuid dualgas a chomhlíonadh.

Tá na Stiúrthóirí neamh-feidhmiúcháin uile neamhspleách ar an mbainistíocht. Comhaltaí den Bhord iad príomhfheidhmeannach mháthair-chuideachta an Chomhlachta, An Post, atá ina Chathaoirleach, agus James Hyland, stiúrthóir neamh-feidhmiúcháin ar An Post. Measann an Bord na Stiúrthóirí neamh-feidhmiúcháin eile a bheith neamhspleách ar an mbonn seo a leanas:

- nár bhfostaí ag an gComhlacht iad le cúig bliana anuas;
- nach bhfuil aon ghaol gnó ábhartha acu leis an gComhlacht agus nach raibh aon ghaol den chineál sin acu le trí bliana anuas;
- nach bhfuil aon luach saothair, seachas a dtáillí mar Stiúrthóirí, á fháil acu;
- nach bhfuil aon ghaol gairid claimne acu le haon chomhairleoir, stiúrthóir nó fostaí sinsearach de chuid an Chomhlachta; agus
- nach bhfuil tras-stiúrthóireachtaí acu ná aon cheangal suaithinseach le Stiúrthóirí eile trí chuideachtaí nó comhlachtaí eile.

Professional development

On appointment, all new Directors take part in an induction programme when they receive information about the Company, the role of the Board and the matters reserved for its decision, the terms of reference and membership of the principal Board and Board committees, the Company's corporate governance practices and procedures, including the responsibilities delegated to Company senior management, and the latest financial information about the Company. This will typically be supplemented by meetings with key senior executives. Throughout their period in office, the Directors are continually updated on the Company's business, the competitive and regulatory environments in which it operates, corporate social responsibility matters and other changes affecting the Company and the lottery industry as a whole, by written briefings and meetings with senior executives. Directors are also advised on appointment of their legal and other duties and obligations as a Director, both in writing and in face-to-face meetings with the Company Secretary. They are also updated on changes to the legal and governance requirements of the Company and upon themselves as Directors.

Performance evaluation

All Directors are appointed to the Board by the Minister for Finance in accordance with Section 14 of the National Lottery Act, 1986 and their terms of office (generally three years) are set out in writing.

The Board has adopted and performed a formal process for the annual evaluation of the performance of the Board and its principal Committees. The Board considers that the introduction of any further formal evaluation of individual Directors is not necessary given the manner of appointment of Directors, the shareholding structure and existing Board procedures.

The Company Secretary

The Company Secretary is a full time employee of the Company's parent company, An Post. The Company Secretary is responsible for advising the Board, through the Chairman, on all governance matters. All Directors have access to the advice and services of the Company Secretary. The Company's Articles of Association provide that the appointment and removal of the Company Secretary is a matter for the full Board.

Information

Regular reports and papers are circulated to the Directors in a timely manner in preparation for Board and Committee meetings. These papers are supplemented by information specifically requested by the Directors from time to time.

The non-executive Directors receive monthly management accounts and regular management reports and information which enables them to scrutinise the Company's and management's performance against agreed objectives.

Forbairt Phroifisiúnta

Arna gceapadh dóibh glacann na Stiúrthóirí nua go léir páirt i gcúrsa inteorach mar a bhfaigheann siad eolas i dtaobh an Chomhlachta, ar ról an Bhoird agus na nithe atá forchoimeáda dá chinneadh, ar théarmaí tagartha agus ar bhallaíocht an Phríomh Bhoird agus choistí an Bhoird, ar chleachtas is ar ghnáthaimh rialachais chorparáidigh an Chomhlachta, ina measc na freagrachtaí atá tarmlichte le bainisteoirí sinsearacha an Chomhlachta, maille leis an eolas airgeadais is déanaí faoin gComhlacht. Déantar é seo trí mhionteagasc i scríbhinn agus trí chruinnithe le feidhmeannaigh shinsearacha. Cuirtear Stiúrthóirí ar an eolas freisin faoin a gcuid dualgas agus oibleagáidí dlíthiúla agus eile mar Stiúrthóirí. Déantar é seo i scríbhinn agus ag cruinnithe i láthair Rúnaí an Chomhlachta. Coinnítear suas chun dáta iad chomh maith faoi athruithe i riachtanais dlíthiúla agus rialachais an Chomhlachta agus a gcuid féin mar Stiúrthóirí.

Meastóireacht ar Fheidhmiú

Ceapann an tAire Airgeadais na Stiúrthóirí uile ar an mBord faoi réir Alt 14 den Acht um Chrannchur Náisiúnta 1986 agus leagtar amach a dtréimhsí oifige (trí bliana sa ghnáthshli) i scríbhinn.

Tá glactha ag an mBord le próiseas foirmiúil chun meastóireacht bhliantúil a dhéanamh ar fheidhmiú an Bhoird agus a phríomhchoistí. Tá an Bord den tuairim nach mbeadh aon mheastóireacht fhoirmiúil bhreise ar Stiúrthóirí aonair riachtanach nuair a chuirtear san áireamh an tslí ina gceaptar Stiúrthóirí, an struchtúr scairseilbh agus na gnáthaimh atá ag an mBord faoi láthair.

Rúnaí an Chomhlachta

Fostaí lánaimseartha de chuid na máthair-chuideachta, An Post, é Rúnaí an Chomhlachta. Tá Rúnaí an Chomhlachta freagrach as eolas a choinneáil leis an mBord tríd an gCathaoirleach ar gach gnó rialachais. Tá fáil ag na Stiúrthóirí uile ar chomhairle is ar sheirbhísí Rúnaí an Chomhlachta. Faoi réir na nAirteagal Comhlachais is gnó don Bhord ina iomláine é Rúnaí an Chomhlachta a cheapadh is a bhriseadh.

Eolas

Cuirtear tuarascála agus páipéir thart ar na Stiúrthóirí in am tráth do chruinnithe Boird is Coistí. Cuirtear leis na páipéir seo trí eolas ar leith a sholáthar de réir mar a iarrann Stiúrthóirí é ó am go chéile.

Faigheann na Stiúrthóirí neamhfheidhmiúcháin cuntais mhíósúla bainistíochta maille le tuairiscí agus eolas rialta ón mbainistíocht, rud a chuireann ar a gcumas mionscrúdú a dhéanamh ar fheidhmiú na bainistíochta agus an Chomhlachta i gcomparáid le spriocanna aontaithe.

Relations with shareholders

The Board and management maintain an ongoing dialogue with the Company's shareholders on strategic issues. In addition, under the National Lottery Act, 1986, certain operational matters require the approval of the Minister for Finance in respect of which ongoing contact with the Minister is maintained.

The Chairman gives feedback to the Board on issues raised with him by the shareholders. All Directors normally attend the Annual General Meeting and shareholders are invited to ask questions during the meeting and to meet with Directors after the formal proceedings have ended.

Internal Control

An ongoing process exists for identifying, evaluating and managing the significant risks faced by the Company. This process, which is based on the Combined Code Guidance for directors issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales (the Turnbull Guidance), is periodically reviewed by the Directors and has been in place throughout the accounting period and up to the date the financial statements were approved.

In accordance with the guidance of the Turnbull committee, the Directors are responsible for the Company's system of internal control, should set appropriate policies on internal control, should seek regular assurance that will enable them to satisfy themselves that the system is functioning effectively and should ensure that the system of internal control is effective in managing risks in the manner which it has been approved. Such a system is designed to manage rather than eliminate business risks and can provide only reasonable rather than absolute assurance against material misstatement or loss.

The Directors have continued to review the effectiveness of the Company's system of financial and non-financial controls, including operational and compliance controls, risk management and the Company's high level internal control arrangements. These reviews have included an assessment of internal controls by management, management assurance of the maintenance of controls, reports from the internal auditor and reports from the external auditor on matters identified in the course of its statutory audit work.

The Company views the careful management of risk as a key management activity. Managing business risk to deliver opportunities is a key element of all activities. This is done using a simple and flexible framework which provides a consistent and sustained way of implementing the Company's values. These business risks, which may be strategic, operational, reputational, financial or environmental, should be understood and visible. The business context determines in each situation the level of acceptable risk and controls.

Caidreamh le Scairshealbhóirí

Bíonn idirphlé leanúnach idir an Bord is an bhainistíocht le scairshealbhóirí an Chomhlachta faoi nithe straitéiseacha. Thairis sin, faoin Acht um Chrannchur Náisiúnta 1986, ní mór faomhadh an Aire Airgeadais a fháil do ghnóthaí oibríochá áirithe agus chuige sin coinnítear teagmháil leanúnach leis an Aire.

Tugann an Cathaoirleach aiseolas don Bhord ar cheisteanna a thógann na scairshealbhóirí leis. Is gnách leis na Stiúrthóirí uile freastal ar an gCruinniú Cinnbhliana agus tugtar cuireadh do na scairshealbhóirí ceisteanna a chur le linn an chruinnithe agus casadh ar na Stiúrthóirí nuair a bhíonn deireadh leis na himeachtaí foirmiúla.

Rialú Inmheánach

Tá próiseas leanúnach ann chun na rioscaí suntasacha, a gcaitheann an Comhlacht aghaidh a thabhairt orthu, a aithint, a mheasúnú agus a bhainistiú. Tá an próiseas seo bunaithe ar Threoracha an Chomhchóid do stiúrthóirí a d'eisigh Institiúid na gCuntasóirí Cairte i Sasana agus sa Bhreatain Bheag (Treoracha Turnbull). Athbhreithníonn na Stiúrthóirí iad ó am go chéile agus bhí feidhm leo le linn na tréimhse cuntasafóichta suas go dtí an dáta ar ar faomhadh na ráitis airgeadais.

Faoi réir na treorach a thugann coiste Turnbull, tá na Stiúrthóirí freagrach as córas rialaithe inmheánaigh an Chomhlachta. REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS

TUARASCÁIL NA STIÚRTHÓIRÍ

Management is responsible for the identification and evaluation of significant risks and for the design and implementation of appropriate internal controls. These risks are assessed on an ongoing basis and are derived from a variety of external and internal sources. Management reports regularly to the Board on the key risks inherent in the business and on the way in which these risks are managed. Management also reports to the Board on any significant changes in the Company's business and on any risks associated with such changes. The process used to identify and manage key risks is an integral part of the internal control environment.

The key procedures which the Directors have established with a view to providing effective internal control are as follows:

- A clear focus on business objectives as determined by the Board after consideration of the statutory responsibilities and risk profile of the Company's business.
- A defined organisational structure with clear lines of responsibility, delegation of authority and segregation of duties designed to foster a beneficial control environment.
- A risk management process which considers the strategy and development of the business in the context of the annual budget process when financial plans and performance targets are set and reviewed by the Board in light of the Company's overall objectives.
- A report and control system which produces a comprehensive set of financial reports. The annual budget is approved by the Board. Key financial statistics are monitored by management on a daily basis. Actual results are reported monthly against budget and any significant adverse variances are examined and remedial action taken.
- Control procedures – comprehensive procedure manuals are maintained by the Company in respect of all its main activities. In particular, there are clearly defined limits and procedures for financial expenditure, including procurement and capital expenditure, and for all draw operations.
- Monitoring system – compliance with control objectives is monitored on an ongoing basis by management. The control system is also monitored by internal audit whose work is focused on the areas of greatest risk to the Company.

The Company has procedures to ensure that appropriate arrangements are in place for employees to be able to raise, in confidence, matters of possible impropriety, with suitable subsequent follow-up action. Reporting channels have been created whereby perceived wrongdoing may be reported orally and via post, telephone and email, anonymously if preferred.

Tá bealaí tuairiscithe ceaptha trínar féidir aon iompar míchuí, a mheastar a bheith ann, a thuairisciú de bhéal, tríd an bpost, thar an teileafón nó i ríomhphost, agus é sin gan ainm a thabhairt más fearr sin.

The Audit Committee

During the year, the Audit Committee comprised James Hyland, Niamh McGowan and Micheál Ó Muircheartaigh. James Hyland acts as Chairman of the Committee. All the members of the Committee are independent non-executive Directors.

Members of the Committee bring to it a wide range of experience from senior positions in business, including that of managing partner of an accounting practice.

Under its terms of reference, the Audit Committee monitors the integrity of the Company's financial statements. The Committee is responsible for monitoring the effectiveness of the external audit process and making recommendations to the Board in relation to the appointment, re-appointment and remuneration of the external auditors. It is responsible for ensuring that an appropriate relationship between the Company and the external auditors is maintained, including reviewing non-audit services and fees. As a result of regulatory or similar requirements, it is necessary to employ the Company's external auditors for certain audit related and non-audit services. In order to maintain the independence of the external auditors, the Committee has determined policies as to what audit related and non-audit services can be provided by the Company's external auditors and the approval process related to these services. In particular, the Board considers it appropriate that independent observer and draw related services, which are the principal constituent of audit related fees paid, be performed by the external auditors. Under these policies, work of a consultancy nature will not be offered to the external auditors unless there are clear efficiencies and value added benefits to the Company while ensuring that the objectivity and independence of the external auditors is maintained. The Committee monitors the level of fees paid to the external auditors.

The Committee reviews annually the Company's systems of internal control and the processes for monitoring and evaluating the risks facing the Company.

The Committee meets with management, as well as privately with the external auditors.

ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the Company's financial statements.

1. Basis of Accounting

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention in accordance with applicable law and Irish Generally Accepted Accounting Practice which includes compliance with the financial reporting standards of the UK Accounting Standards Board as promulgated by The Institute of Chartered Accountants in Ireland.

2. Turnover

Turnover from the sale of National Lottery tickets is recognised as the tickets are sold, with adjustments being made for Scratch Card ticket stocks held by agents and for multi draw tickets / advance tickets.

All turnover is derived from and originates in Ireland.

3. Prizes

The prize structure complies with the requirements of Section 4(2) of the National Lottery Act, 1986 whereby, taking one year with another, not less than 40% of the total monies received by the Company in respect of the sale of National Lottery tickets shall be distributed in prizes. Prizes are provided for as revenue is recognised on the basis of the game's particular prize structure. Any difference between the total amount provided and the amounts actually distributed is included in Creditors in the Balance Sheet.

4. Advertising and Promotional Expenditure

Advertising and promotional expenditure is written off in full in the year in which the costs are incurred.

5. Leased Assets - Operating

Operating lease rentals are charged to the Profit and Loss Account on a straight line basis over the lease term.

6. Taxation

The Company is exempt from Corporation Tax under Section 220 Taxes Consolidation Act, 1997.

7. Fixed Assets - Tangible Assets

Tangible assets are shown as having no book value, as the total cost thereof to the Company is reimbursed out of the National Lottery Fund.

Accordingly, no depreciation is provided.

Under Section 17(1) (a) of the National Lottery Act, 1986, the Company holds these assets in trust for the State.

POLASAITHE CUNTASAÍOCHTA

1. Bunús na Cuntasaíochta

Ullmhaítear na ráitis airgeadais de réir dlíthe oiriúnacha na hÉireann agus na gCleachtas Cuntasaíochta, a bhfuil gnáth-ghlacadh leo in Éirinn, ar a áirítear cloí leis na caighdeáin a d'eisigh an UK Accounting Standards Board ar thuairisciú airgeadais agus a d'fhoilsigh Institiúid na gCuntasóirí Cairte in Éirinn.

2. Láimhdeachas

Aithnítear an láimhdeachas ó dhíolachán thicéid an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta de réir mar a dhíoltar na ticéid agus déantar coigeartuithe don stoc ticéad scríobcháirtaí a choinníonn na gníomhairí agus do thicéid / réamh-thicéid- ilchrannchuir.

As Éirinn a thagann agus is in Éirinn a fhaightear an láimhdeachas uile.

3. Duaiseanna

Tá an duais-struchtúr ag teacht le forálacha Alt 4(2) den Acht um Chrannchur Náisiúnta 1986. Faoi na forálacha seo, agus bliain amháin á ghlacadh le bliain eile, dáilfead mar dhuaiseanna suim nach lú ná 40% den airgead iomlán a fuair an Comhlacht mar thoradh ar dhíolachán thicéid an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta. Déantar soláthar do na duaiseanna de réir mar a aithnítear an t-ioncam. Léirítear i measc na gCreidiúnaithe ar an gClár Comhardaithe cibé dífríocht a bhíonn idir an tsuim iomlán a sholáthraítear agus na suimeanna a dháiltear.

4. Caiteachas ar Fhógraíocht is ar Chur Chun Cinn

Díscríobhtar iomlán an chaiteachais ar fhógraíocht is ar chur chun cinn sa bhliain ina tharraingítear na costais.

5. Sócmhainní ar léasanna oibriúcháin

Gearrtar costas chíosanna ar léasanna oibriúcháin ar an gCuntas Brabúis agus Caillteanais ar bhonn mhéid chothroim thar thréimhse an léasa.

6. Cánachas

Tá díolúine ag an gComhlacht ó Cháin Chorparáide faoi Alt 220 den Acht Comhdhlúite Cánacha 1997.

7. Sócmhainní Seasta – Sócmhainní Inláimhsithe

Ní léirítear aon leabharluach a bheith ag sócmhainní inláimhsithe ón uair go n-aisíoctar a gcostas iomlán leis an gComhlacht as Ciste an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta.

Dá réir, ní thagann aon mhúirear dímheasa i gceist.

I gcás na sócmhainní seo, feidhmíonn an Comhlacht mar iontaobhaí thar ceann an Stáit, faoi Alt 17(1) (a) d'Acht um Chrannchur Náisiúnta 1986.

ACCOUNTING POLICIES

8. Fixed Assets - Financial Assets

Financial fixed assets are shown at cost less provisions for impairments in value. Income from financial fixed assets is recognised in the Profit and Loss Account in the year in which it is receivable.

9. Stocks

Stocks comprise Scratch Card ticket stocks and are valued at cost. Cost includes import duties, V.A.T. and transport costs. All unusable and obsolete stock is written off.

10. Foreign Currencies

Transactions denominated in foreign currencies are translated into Euro and recorded at the rate of exchange ruling at the date of the transaction. Monetary liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated into Euro at the rate of exchange ruling at the Balance Sheet date or at forward purchase contract rates where such contracts exist. All exchange differences are dealt with in the Profit and Loss Account.

11. Pensions

Pensions are provided to seconded staff under multi-employer defined benefit superannuation schemes which are administered by the Company's parent, An Post, and a defined contribution scheme. In relation to the defined contribution scheme, contributions are accrued and recognised in operating profit or loss in the period in which they are earned by the relevant staff.

Due to the seconded nature of staff, the Company is unable to identify its share of the underlying assets and liabilities in the defined benefit scheme which may be attributable to the Company on a consistent and reasonable basis. Because of this, as permitted by FRS 17, the defined benefit schemes are accounted for by the Company as if the schemes were defined contribution schemes.





16. Pensions

The pension entitlements of staff arise under a number of An Post externally funded defined benefit and defined contribution pension schemes, the assets of which are vested in independent trustees appointed by An Post for the sole benefit of employees and their dependants.

An Post operates multi-employer defined benefit schemes. Due to the seconded nature of staff the Company is unable to identify the share of the underlying assets and liabilities in the schemes, which may be attributable to the Company, on a consistent and reasonable basis. Because of this, as permitted by FRS17, the schemes have been accounted for by the Company as if the schemes were defined contribution schemes.

The valuations of the An Post defined benefit schemes used for the purposes of the FRS17 disclosures have been based on the previous actuarial valuations carried out at 1 January 2008, updated by the independent actuaries in accordance with FRS17 to assess the schemes' liabilities at 31 December 2008. The schemes' assets were stated at their market value at that date. The net pension liabilities of the pension schemes at 31 December 2009, the most recently available information, amounted to €403 million (31 December 2008: €582 million). An Post had 10,086 permanent employees not including the 99 staff of An Post National Lottery Company.

The pension costs of the An Post defined benefit schemes are assessed in accordance with the advice of an independent professionally qualified actuary. The most recent actuarial valuations were carried out at 1 January 2008, using the attained age method and disclosed that the assets of the schemes at that date were sufficient to cover more than 100% of the accrued liabilities after allowing for expected future increases in pensionable remuneration.

Contributions to the defined benefit schemes were at a rate of 14.4% (2008: 14.4%) of pensionable remuneration.

The actuarial valuations are not available for public inspection but the results of the valuations have been advised to members of the schemes.

Employer contributions to the defined contribution scheme are at rates varying between 5% and 9% of pensionable remuneration.

The total pension cost in respect of the Company for the year ended 31 December 2009 was €885,000 (2008: €837,000).

An amount of €10,000 is included in accruals (2008: €11,000) representing contributions payable to An Post with respect to the pension schemes at 31 December 2009.

17. Contingencies

There were no material contingent liabilities at the balance sheet date.

16. Pinsin

Bunaíodh luachálacha scéimeanna sochar sainithe An Post, chun críche faisnéisithe FRS 17, ar luachálacha achtúireacha a rinneadh roimhe sin ar 1 Eanáir 2008 agus a thug na hachtúiríthe neamhspleácha suas chun dáta faoi réir FRS 17 chun measúnú a dhéanamh ar dhliteanas na scéime ar 31 Nollaig 2008. Luadh sócmhainní na scéime ar a luach margaidh ar an dáta sin. B'é €403 milliún glansócmhainní na scéimeanna pinsin ar 31 Nollaig 2009 (31 Nollaig 2008: €582 milliún), an dáta deiridh ar a raibh eolas le fáil. Bhí 10,086 buanfhostaí ag An Post gan 99 fostaí de chuid Chomhlacht Chrannchuir Náisiúnta An Post a chur san áireamh.

Measúnaítear costais scéimeanna pinsin le sochar sainithe An Post faoi réir chomhairle ó achtúire neamhspleách atá oilte go gairmiúil. Rinneadh an luacháil achtúireach dheiridh ar 1 Eanáir 2008 agus modh na haoise sroichte á úsáid. Fuarthas amach gur leor na sócmhainní ar an dáta sin chun 100% agus breis den dliteanas fabhráithe a chlúdach tar éis soláthar a dhéanamh do arduithe measta i luach saothair inphinsin.

Bhí na ranníocaíochtaí do na scéimeanna le sochar réamh-shainnithe ar ráta 14.4% (2008: 14.4%) de thuarastal inphinsithe.

Níl fáil ar na luachálacha achtúireacha le go ndéanfaí scrúdú orthu go poiblí ach tá torthaí na luachálacha curtha in iúl do chomhaltaí na scéimeanna.

Is ar rátaí idir 5% agus 9% den tuarastal inphinsinithe atá ranníocaíochtaí na bhfostóirí leis na scéimeanna le ranníocaíochtaí sainnithe.

B'é €885,000 costas iomlán na bpinsean i leith an Chomhlachta sa bhliain dar críoch 31 Nollaig 2009 (2008: €837,000).

Tá suim de €10,000 san áireamh sna fabhrúithe (2008: €11,000) i leith ranníocaíochtaí atá iníochta le An Post i leith na scéime pinsin ar 31 Nollaig 2009.

19. Group Membership and Controlling Party

The Company is a subsidiary undertaking of An Post which holds 80% of the issued share capital.

The sole activity of the Company is the operation of the National Lottery under Licence from the Minister for Finance in accordance with the provisions of the National Lottery Act, 1986. The Licence expires on 31 December 2011. The surplus generated each year is entirely attributable to the National Lottery Fund and, accordingly, the results of the Company are not consolidated within the An Post Group.

The Company was managed and controlled throughout the year by the Directors on behalf of An Post and the ultimate controlling party, the Minister for Finance.

20. Related Party Disclosures

In addition to the secondment of staff working in the Company, undertakings in the An Post Group provide the Company with management and delivery of services. Such services are carried out on an arm's length basis or, where appropriate, in accordance with the terms of the Licence granted by the Minister for Finance to the Company, to operate the National Lottery. An Post also provides agency services to the Company whereby An Post makes sales and pays prizes on behalf of the Company in accordance with the standard terms and conditions and remuneration structure common to all of the Company's agents.

Excluding staff costs (Note 6) and including the Management Fee, expenses for the year in respect of services provided by An Post Group undertakings to the Company amounted to €6,346,000 (2008: €6,128,000).

Amounts due to An Post are set out in Note 12 of the accounts.

The Company's parent, An Post, has agreed to guarantee the performance by the Company of its obligations under the Licence for the holding of the National Lottery granted by the Minister for Finance. An Post has provided the guarantee, the maximum liability of which amounts to €10 million, for the duration of the Licence.

21. Board Approval

The financial statements were approved by the Board of Directors on 23 February 2010.
