RULES

1. Title

These rules are to be read in conjunction with and are in addition to, the General Rules for the National Lottery and the General Raffle Rules.

1. These Rules may be referred to as the Easter Millionaire Raffle Rules (Draw 006)
2. These Rules shall come into force on the 15th day of January, 2010.

2. Definitions

In these Rules unless the context requires otherwise:

Act means the National Lottery Act 1986, as amended.

Central Computer System means the computer system used to operate on-line Lottery Games.

Easter Millionaire Raffle Preliminary Draw means the draw which is used to randomly select the required number of valid entries for inclusion in the Easter Millionaire Raffle Final Draw.

Easter Millionaire Raffle Game means a lottery game that is of limited duration, having pre-established and announced beginning and end sales and Draw Date. A limited number of Tickets each unique from all others, will be offered for the opportunity to win one of a number of predetermined and announced prizes.

Company means An Post National Lottery Company.

Draw or Drawing or Easter Millionaire Raffle Final Draw means the process which is used to randomly select a Winning Ticket for a given Easter Millionaire Raffle Game.

Draw Number means the three-digit number printed underneath the Unique Multiple-Digit Number on the Ticket that indicates the number of a particular Easter Millionaire Raffle Final Draw.

Draw Date means the date printed on the Ticket that indicates when a particular Easter Millionaire Raffle Final Draw takes place.

Lotto Agent means a person authorised to sell Instant and On-Line Game Tickets at specified location(s) under section 7 of the National Lottery Act 1986.

On-Line Game means a Lottery Game in which a Player purchases a Raffle Ticket through a Lotto Agent to enable entry to the Easter Millionaire Raffle Game.

Player means a person participating in an Easter Millionaire Raffle Game.

The National Lottery means An Post National Lottery Company.

Ticket means an Easter Millionaire Raffle Ticket with a Unique Multiple-Digit Number, Draw Number, Draw Date and other information as determined by The National Lottery from time to time entitling its owner to participate in an Easter Millionaire Raffle Game.

Unclaimed Prize means any award, financial or otherwise, as set out in these Rules for which exists physical, tangible evidence of eligibility but for which the prize remains unclaimed 90 days following the Easter Millionaire Raffle Draw.

Unique Multiple-Digit Number means the multi-digit number printed on the Ticket to enable a Player's entry to the Easter Millionaire Raffle Draw. The Unique Multiple-Digit Number is issued in consecutive numerical sequence by the Central Computer System.

Winning Ticket means an Easter Millionaire Raffle Ticket with a computer-generated Unique Multiple-Digit Number corresponding to the Unique Multiple-Digit Number chosen in the Draw and with a Draw Number corresponding to the Draw in which the Unique Multiple Digit Number is chosen and subsequently validated by The National Lottery.

3. The Easter Millionaire Raffle Game

The Easter Millionaire Raffle Game is an On-Line Game which will commence on a date and at times to be decided by the Company.

4. Player's Objective

The objective of a Player in an Easter Millionaire Raffle Game is to have his Unique Multi-Digit Number drawn as one of the Winning Tickets in the Easter Millionaire Raffle Draw to be held on 5th April, 2010 or other date to be decided and announced by the Company.

5. Method of Play

(1) Cost of a Ticket

The price of an Easter Millionaire Raffle Ticket will be €20.

(2) Entry into a Game

Only those Tickets which are valid for an Easter Millionaire Raffle Draw will be entered into the Easter Millionaire Raffle Draw.

(3) Sale of Tickets

- (a) Sales of Easter Millionaire Raffle Tickets will begin on 1st February, 2010 (or other date to be decided by the Company) and will end in advance of a Draw, on a date specified and announced by the Company. Sales may end before the specified end date if the entire pool of tickets for a particular Draw is sold prior to the specified end date.
- (b) No Ticket shall be sold to any person under the age of eighteen years, but this shall not be deemed to prohibit the purchase of a Ticket for the purpose of making a gift by a person eighteen years of age or older to a person less than that age. Any Lotto Agent who knowingly sells or offers to sell a Ticket or share to any person under the age of eighteen years shall be liable to prosecution.

6. Drawings and Division of Prizes

(1) Selection of Winning Tickets

- (a) At the Easter Millionaire Raffle Preliminary Draw there shall be randomly selected 707 entries and reserves from all valid Easter Millionaire Raffle Tickets purchased for the Game to participate in the Easter Millionaire Raffle Final Draw in accordance with the General Raffle Rules and procedures.

(2) Categories of Prizes

Fixed prize values in the Easter Millionaire Raffle Final Draw will be as follows:

- Division 1 :** There will be two (2) Jackpot prizes of €1,000,000 each
- Division 2 :** There will be five (5) prizes of €100,000 each
- Division 3 :** There will be ten (10) prizes of €10,000 each
- Division 4 :** There will be fifteen (15) prizes of €5,000 each
- Division 5 :** There will be twenty-five (25) prizes of €1,000 each
- Division 6 :** There will be fifty (50) prizes of €500 each
- Division 7 :** There will be one hundred (100) prizes of €250 each
- Division 8 :** There will be five hundred (500) prizes of €100 each

(3) Determination of Prize Claims

The determination of prize claims and validation of prizes shall be subject to the requirements of the General Raffle Rules.

7. Payment of Prizes and Ticket Validation Requirements

(1) Payment of Prizes

Prizes in all prize divisions may be available for payment on the day following the Easter Millionaire Raffle Final Draw in accordance with the General Raffle Rules. .

(2) Ticket Validation Requirements

Easter Millionaire Raffle Tickets shall be validated in accordance with the General Raffle Rules.

8. Claiming a Prize

(1) Time Limit on Claims

All prizes must be claimed within 90 days from the date of the Easter Millionaire Raffle Draw. Any prize not claimed within the 90 day period in the manner specified in these Rules and the General Raffle Rules shall be forfeited and the unclaimed prize money shall be allocated to future National Lottery Games.

9. General

- (a) The National Lottery's decisions and judgements in respect to the determination of a winning Ticket or of any other dispute arising from the payment or awarding

of prizes shall be final and binding upon all Players and any other person or persons concerned for any reason with these matters unless otherwise provided by law and these Rules and the General Raffle Rules. In the event that a dispute arises relative to the winning Ticket, a claim form, the payment, or the awarding of any prize, The National Lottery may withhold payment of the prize winnings until a decision has been reached.

- (b) Where the context so requires, in these game rules, the neuter gender shall include the feminine or masculine gender and vice versa, the feminine gender shall include the masculine gender and vice-versa and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.

10. Decisions of National Lottery Binding

All decisions of The National Lottery concerning the Easter Millionaire Raffle Game or the Easter Millionaire Raffle Draw, including decisions as to the validity of Tickets, the identity of the bearer of any Ticket, the determination of prize winners, the amount and category of prize money, the interpretation, application, meaning and effect of these rules, the General Raffle Rules and The National Lottery's procedures shall be final and binding on all Players, and any other person or persons concerned for any reason with these matters.
