The National Lottery

Rules for Interactive Instant Win Game “Digital All Cash Platinum”

A. GENERAL

- 1) These are the Interactive Instant Win Game Specific Rules for the Game called “Digital All Cash Platinum” (hereinafter known as the “Specific Rules”) which will be operated by the National Lottery.
- 2) The General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games contain the general rules which apply to all Interactive Instant Win Games. For further information, please click [here](#). Additionally, both sets of rules can be obtained from Lottery Headquarters.
- 3) When you play “Digital All Cash Platinum”, these Specific Rules, the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, the Account Terms and the Data Privacy Statement apply. If there is any conflict or inconsistency between these Specific Rules and the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, these Specific Rules will prevail (unless the Company states otherwise).
- 4) The Game will commence on the date it is made available on the Interactive Channels and will remain available until such time as it is removed from the Interactive Channels. The Company reserves the right to recommence the Game at any time and for such duration as the Company decides at its sole discretion.
- 5) These Specific Rules have been approved by the Regulator in accordance with Section 45 of the Act.

- 8) Where the context so requires, in these Specific Rules, the neutral gender shall include the feminine or masculine gender and vice versa, the feminine gender shall include the masculine gender and vice-versa and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.
- 9) Capitalised words and expressions defined in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms but not herein shall have the same meanings as those set out in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms when used herein.

B. COST OF PLAY

- 1) The price of a “Digital All Cash Platinum” play will be €5.

C. HOW TO PLAY “DIGITAL ALL CASH PLATINUM”

- 1) The Player chooses the “Digital All Cash Platinum” Game by clicking on the “Play” link on the Game Play Window. The opening screen below is then displayed.



- 2) The Player clicks ‘Play’ to continue. The Player is presented with a screen which shows ‘GAME 1’.
- 3) In ‘GAME 1’ the Player is required to click/tap on each of the eight “€” icons to reveal a cash amount. The aim of ‘GAME 1’ is to match three identical cash amounts to win that amount. These amounts will increase in size and highlight in yellow to indicate the prize won.



- 4) A Player can win once on ‘GAME 1’.
- 5) Once the Player completes ‘GAME 1’ the Player is then prompted to click the ‘SWITCH TO GAME 2’ arrow to move on to ‘GAME 2’.
- 6) In ‘GAME 2’ the Player must click/tap on each of the twelve platinum bar icons to reveal a symbol. Any of the following play symbols may be revealed in

'GAME 2': 'Crown', 'Treasure Chest', 'Roll of Notes', 'Rainbow', 'Wallet', 'Stack of Coins' or 'Piggy Bank'.



- 7) The aim of 'GAME 2' is to match three identical symbols to win the corresponding amount in the 'PRIZE TABLE'. A yellow keyline will be applied to the outline of the matching symbols and the associated row in the 'PRIZE TABLE' will highlight in yellow to indicate the prize amount won.
- 8) The Player can win once on 'GAME 2'.
- 9) Once the Player completes 'GAME 2' the Player is then prompted to click the 'SWITCH TO GAME 3' arrow to move to 'GAME 3'.
- 10) In 'GAME 3' the Player is required to click/tap on each of the two '?' icons under 'WINNING NUMBERS' to reveal a number and click/tap on each of the ten star icons under 'YOUR NUMBERS' to reveal a number and a prize amount.

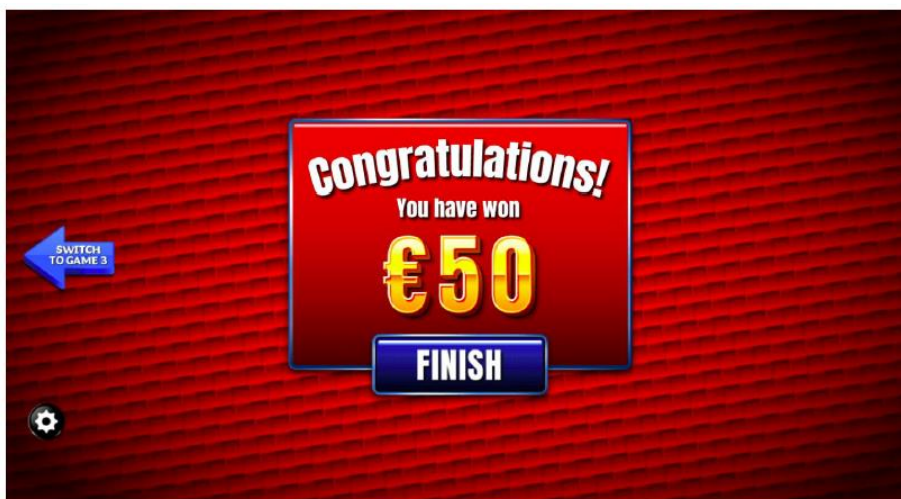


- 11) The aim of 'GAME 3' is to match either 'WINNING NUMBER' to any of the 'YOUR NUMBERS' to win the Prize associated with that number. The

matching numbers and associated prize amount will highlight in yellow to indicate the prize amount won.

12) The Player can win up to ten times on 'GAME 3'.

13) Once the Player has played, a message indicating the result will appear.

14) The Player is required to acknowledge this message by clicking the "FINISH" button.

15) The Game then ends, and the Player is presented with a screen confirming the outcome.

E. PRIZE AMOUNTS, NUMBER OF PRIZES AND ODDS OF WINNING VARIOUS PRIZES

- 1) The prize table that is set out below provides details on the Prizes that are available to win in "Digital All Cash Platinum" and the odds of winning same.
- 2) The determination of whether or not a Player has won a Prize (and the level of any such Prize) is randomly determined by the Central Gaming System at the point of purchase of the Play.
