## The National Lottery

### Rules for Interactive Instant Win Game “Digital All Cash Spectacular”

#### A. GENERAL

- 1) These are the Interactive Instant Win Game Specific Rules for the Game called “Digital All Cash Spectacular” (hereinafter known as the “Specific Rules”) which will be operated by the National Lottery.
- 2) The General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games contain the general rules which apply to all Interactive Instant Win Games. For further information, please click [here](#). Additionally, both sets of rules can be obtained from Lottery Headquarters.
- 3) When you play “Digital All Cash Spectacular”, these Specific Rules, the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, the Account Terms and the Data Privacy Statement apply. If there is any conflict or inconsistency between these Specific Rules and the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, these Specific Rules will prevail (unless the Company states otherwise).
- 4) The Game will commence on the date it is made available on the Interactive Channels and will remain available until such time as it is removed from the Interactive Channels. The Company reserves the right to recommence the Game at any time and for such duration as the Company decides at its sole discretion.
- 5) These Specific Rules have been approved by the Regulator in accordance with Section 45 of the Act.

- 8) Where the context so requires, in these Specific Rules, the neutral gender shall include the feminine or masculine gender and vice versa, the feminine gender shall include the masculine gender and vice-versa and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.
- 9) Capitalised words and expressions defined in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms but not herein shall have the same meanings as those set out in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms when used herein.

## B. COST OF PLAY

- 1) The price of a “Digital All Cash Spectacular” play will be €10.

## C. HOW TO PLAY “DIGITAL ALL CASH SPECTACULAR”

- 1) The Player chooses the “Digital All Cash Spectacular” Game by clicking on the “Play” link on the Game Play Window. The opening screen below is then displayed.



- 2) The Player clicks 'PLAY' to continue. The Player is presented with a screen which shows 'GAME 1'.
- 3) The cash amounts to be revealed in a “Digital All Cash Spectacular” Play will be derived from the following set:  
  
€200,000, €10,000, €5,000, €1,000, €500, €200, €100, €50, €25, €20, €10.
- 4) 'GAME 1' is displayed on screen and shows six “€” icons. The Player must click/tap each of the six icons to reveal cash amounts. The aim of 'GAME 1' is to match three identical cash amounts to win that amount. The matching amounts will increase in size and will be highlighted in yellow to indicate the Prize won.





- 5) Once the Player completes 'GAME 1' the Player is then prompted to click the 'SWITCH TO GAME 2' arrow to move on to 'GAME 2'.
- 6) 'GAME 2' is displayed on screen and shows 'WINNING NUMBERS' which consists of five star icons and 'YOUR NUMBERS' which consists of twenty four 'gold bars' icons.
- 7) The aim of 'GAME 2' is to match any of the 'WINNING NUMBERS' with any of 'YOUR NUMBERS' to win the Prize associated with that number. The matching numbers and associated prize amount will highlight in yellow to indicate the Prize won.



- 8) If the Player reveals a 'Gem' symbol under 'YOUR NUMBERS' in 'GAME 2' the Player wins the associated Prize shown for that symbol. If the Player reveals a 'Gold Crown' under 'YOUR NUMBERS' in 'GAME 2' the Player wins double the prize shown for that symbol. If the Player reveals a 'VIP CARD' under 'YOUR NUMBERS' in 'GAME 2' the Player wins €50.
- 9) The Player can win up to twenty-five Prizes across 'GAME 1' and 'GAME 2'.
- 10) Once the Player has played, a message indicating the result will appear.

- 11) The Player is required to acknowledge this message by clicking the "FINISH" button.
- 12) The Game then ends, and the Player is presented with a screen confirming the outcome.

#### **E. PRIZE AMOUNTS, NUMBER OF PRIZES AND ODDS OF WINNING VARIOUS PRIZES**

- 1) The prize table that is set out below provides details on the Prizes that are available to win in "Digital All Cash Spectacular" and the odds of winning same.
- 2) The determination of whether or not a Player has won a Prize (and the level of any such Prize) is randomly determined by the Central Gaming System at the point of purchase of the Play.
- 3) Game sounds, animation and Player interfaces are solely for entertainment purposes and do not impact on the outcome of the Game.
