## The National Lottery

Rules for Interactive Instant Win Game "Digital Fire 4s Ice 5s"

## A. GENERAL

1) These are the Interactive Instant Win Game Specific Rules for the Game called "Digital Fire 4s Ice 5s" (hereinafter known as the "Specific Rules") which will be operated by the National Lottery.
2) The General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games contain the general rules which apply to all Interactive Instant Win Games. For further information, please click here. Additionally, both sets of rules can be obtained from Lottery Headquarters.
3) When you play "Digital Fire 4s Ice 5s", these Specific Rules, the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, the Account Terms and the Data Privacy Statement apply. If there is any conflict or inconsistency between these Specific Rules and the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, these Specific Rules will prevail (unless the Company states otherwise).
4) The Game will commence on the date it is made available on the Interactive Channels and will remain available until such time as it is removed from the Interactive Channels. The Company reserves the right to recommence the Game at any time and for such duration as the Company decides at its sole discretion.
5) These Specific Rules have been approved by the Regulator in accordance with Section 45 of the Act.

8) Where the context so requires, in these Specific Rules, the neutral gender shall include the feminine or masculine gender and vice versa, the feminine gender shall include the masculine gender and vice-versa and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.
9) Capitalised words and expressions defined in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms but not herein shall have the same meanings as those set out in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms when used herein.

## B. COST OF PLAY

1) The price of a "Digital Fire 4 s Ice 5 s " play will be $€ 5$.

## C. HOW TO PLAY "DIGITAL FIRE 4S ICE 5S"

1) The Player chooses the "Digital Fire 4 s Ice 5 s " Game by clicking on the "Play" link on the Game Play Window. The opening screen below is then displayed.

2) The Player clicks "Play" to continue. The Player is presented with a screen which displays two game panels designated Fire 4s and Ice 5s. The Fire 4s panel contains one set of two "Euro" icons designated 'WINNING NUMBERS' and a set of ten 'Flame' icons designated 'YOUR NUMBERS' and the Ice 5s panel contains one set of two "Euro" icons designated 'WINNING NUMBERS' and a set of ten 'Ice Cube' icons designated 'YOUR NUMBERS'. The Player must click on each icon to reveal a number.

3) The aim of the Game in each panel is to match any of the numbers revealed in 'WINNING NUMBERS' to any of the numbers revealed in 'YOUR NUMBERS' to win the prize amount shown below that number. If a player reveals a '4' symbol in 'WINNING NUMBERS' under the Fire 4s panel and/or a ' 5 ' symbol in 'WINNING NUMBERS' under the Ice 5 s panel, then the player
wins the prize amount appended to the 'Flame' or 'Ice Cube' symbol instantly. Each panel plays separately.
4) The Player can click on the icons in any order to reveal 'WINNING NUMBERS' and 'YOUR NUMBERS'. Any matching number(s) on the Fire 4s panel will be highlighted in red and any matching number(s) on the Ice 5 s panel will be highlighted in blue.

5) The Player can win up to twenty prizes in a Play.
6) The Player will win a prize equal to the total of all prize amount(s) appended to a matched number(s) revealed in the Game.
7) Once the Player has played, a message indicating the result will appear:

8) The Player is required to acknowledge this message by clicking the "FINISH" button.
9) The Game then ends, and the Player is presented with a screen confirming the outcome.
