The National Lottery

Rules for Interactive Instant Win Game “Digital Lucky 7s”

A. GENERAL

- 1) These are the Interactive Instant Win Game Specific Rules for the Game called “Digital Lucky 7s” (hereinafter known as the “Specific Rules”) which will be operated by the National Lottery.
- 2) The General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games contain the general rules which apply to all Interactive Instant Win Games. For further information, please click [here](#). Additionally, both sets of rules can be obtained from Lottery Headquarters.
- 3) When you play “Digital Lucky 7s”, these Specific Rules, the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, the Account Terms and the Data Privacy Statement apply. If there is any conflict or inconsistency between these Specific Rules and the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, these Specific Rules will prevail (unless the Company states otherwise).
- 4) The Game will commence on the date it is made available on the Interactive Channels and will remain available until such time as it is removed from the Interactive Channels. The Company reserves the right to recommence the Game at any time and for such duration as the Company decides at its sole discretion.
- 5) These Specific Rules have been approved by the Regulator in accordance with Section 45 of the Act.

- 8) Where the context so requires, in these Specific Rules, the neutral gender shall include the feminine or masculine gender and vice versa, the feminine gender shall include the masculine gender and vice-versa and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.
- 9) Capitalised words and expressions defined in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms but not herein shall have the same meanings as those set out in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms when used herein.

B. COST OF PLAY

- 1) The price of a “Digital Lucky 7s” play will be €10.

C. HOW TO PLAY “DIGITAL LUCKY 7S”

- 1) The Player chooses the “Digital Lucky 7s” Game by clicking on the “Play” link on the Game Play Window. The opening screen below is then displayed.



- 2) The Player clicks ‘Play’ to continue. The Player is presented with a screen which shows ‘GAMES 1-4’.



- 3) In ‘GAMES 1-4’ the Player is required to tap the row in each game to reveal three numbers and an associated amount. The aim of ‘GAMES 1-4’ is to find three ‘7’ symbols within the same game to win the corresponding Prize.
- 4) A Player can win up to four times in ‘GAMES 1-4’.
- 5) Once the Player completes ‘GAMES 1-4’ the Player is then prompted to click the ‘Arrow’ to move on to ‘GAMES 5-8’.



- 6) In 'GAMES 5-8' the Player is required to tap the two (2) 'Gold Star' icons in each game to reveal two numbers, the sum of those numbers and an associated Prize amount. The aim of 'GAMES 5-8' is to reveal the sum of the two numbers added together to equal 7 within the same game to win the corresponding Prize.
- 7) A Player can win up to four times in 'GAMES 5-8'.
- 8) Once the Player completes 'GAME 5-8' the Player is then prompted to click the 'Arrow' to move on to 'GAME 9'.



- 9) In GAME 9' the Player is required to tap the two (2) 'Gold Coin' play icons to reveal two (2) 'WINNING SYMBOLS' and tap five (5) '€' play icons to reveal five (5) 'YOUR SYMBOLS' each with an associated Prize amount. The aim of 'GAME 9' is to match any of the 'WINNING SYMBOLS' to any of 'YOUR SYMBOLS' to win the Prize shown for that symbol.
- 10) A Player can win up to five times in 'GAME 9'.
- 11) Once the Player completes 'GAME 9' the Player is then prompted to click the 'Arrow' to move to 'GAME 10'.



- 12) In 'GAME 10' the Player is required to tap the eight (8) 'Gold Bar' play icons to reveal eight (8) cash amounts. The aim of 'GAME 10' is to match (3) identical cash amounts to win that amount.
- 13) A Player can win once in 'GAME 10'.
- 14) Once the Player completes 'GAME 10' the Player is then prompted to click the 'Arrow' to move to the 'LUCKY SPOT'.
- 15) The Player is required to tap the 'LUCKY SPOT' and reveal a cash amount to win that Prize.
- 16) The Player clicks "Play" to continue. The Player is presented with a screen which shows;

- 17) The Player is required to acknowledge this message by clicking the "FINISH" button.
- 18) The Game then ends, and the Player is presented with a screen confirming the outcome.

PRIZE AMOUNTS, NUMBER OF PRIZES AND ODDS OF WINNING VARIOUS PRIZES

- 1) The prize table that is set out below provides details on the Prizes that are available to win in “Digital Lucky 7s” and the odds of winning same.
- 2) The determination of whether or not a Player has won a Prize (and the level of any such Prize) is randomly determined by the Central Gaming System at the point of purchase of the Play.
- 3) Game sounds, animation and Player interfaces are solely for entertainment purposes and do not impact on the outcome of the Game.
