## The National Lottery

### Rules for Interactive Instant Win Game “Koi Kash”

#### A. GENERAL

- 1) These are the Interactive Instant Win Game Specific Rules for the Game called “Koi Kash” (hereinafter known as the “Specific Rules”) which will be operated by the National Lottery.
- 2) The General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games contain the general rules which apply to all Interactive Instant Win Games. For further information, please click [here](#). Additionally, both sets of rules can be obtained from Lottery Headquarters.
- 3) When you play “Koi Kash”, these Specific Rules, the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, the Account Terms and the Data Privacy Statement apply. If there is any conflict or inconsistency between these Specific Rules and the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, these Specific Rules will prevail (unless the Company states otherwise).
- 4) The Game will commence on the date it is made available on the Interactive Channels and will remain available until such time as it is removed from the Interactive Channels. The Company reserves the right to recommence the Game at any time and for such duration as the Company decides at its sole discretion.
- 5) These Specific Rules have been approved by the Regulator in accordance with Section 45 of the Act.

- 8) Where the context so requires, in these Specific Rules, the neutral gender shall include the feminine or masculine gender and vice versa, the feminine gender shall include the masculine gender and vice-versa and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.
- 9) Capitalised words and expressions defined in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms but not herein shall have the same meanings as those set out in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms when used herein.

## B. COST OF PLAY

- 1) The price of a “Koi Kash” play will be €3.

## C. HOW TO PLAY “KOI KASH”

- 1) The Player chooses the “Koi Kash” Game by clicking on the “Play” link on the Game Play Window. The opening screen below is then displayed.



- 2) The Player clicks “Play” to continue. The Player is presented with a screen which shows nine (9) ‘Box’ play icons in a 3 x 3 configuration, a ‘PRIZE POT’ meter, used to display any banked wins and a ‘DOUBLER’ panel containing a doubler icon required to double any banked wins.



- 3) The aim of the Game is to reveal three (3) matching cash amounts to win/bank that amount and/or reveal a ‘Koi Fish Doubler’ icon to double any banked prize(s).
- 4) Any of the following ten cash amounts can be revealed from the ‘Box’ play icons:  
 €3, €5, €10, €20, €30, €50, €100, €500, €1k (€1,000) or €30k (€30,000).

- 5) To commence Play the Player must click one of the nine (9) 'Box' play icons to reveal a cash amount or a 'Koi Fish Doubler'. The play icons can be clicked in any order. If a Player matches three cash amounts, he wins that amount and the Prize achieved is automatically transferred into the 'PRIZE POT'.
- 6) Once the Prize is banked, the game will remove the three prize winning reveals and replace them with three new 'Box' play icons from which to reveal more cash amounts or the 'Koi Fish Doubler' icon if not already revealed. No more than one (1) instance of the 'Koi Fish Doubler' icon can appear within a game.
- 7) If a Player reveals a 'Koi Fish Doubler' icon from one of the play icons, this will remain on screen. The koi fish icon with the DOUBLER panel will animate to show that any banked wins will be doubled.



- 8) Once all the visible 'Box' play icons have been revealed and there are no instances of three of the same cash amounts, the game will transition to the game end screen.
- 9) A Player can win up to ten (10) times in any Game.
- 10) Once the Player has played, a message indicating the result will appear:

- 11) The Player is required to acknowledge this message by clicking the “FINISH” button.
- 12) The Game then ends, and the Player is presented with a screen confirming the outcome.

#### **E. PRIZE AMOUNTS, NUMBER OF PRIZES AND ODDS OF WINNING VARIOUS PRIZES**

- 1) The prize table that is set out below provides details on the Prizes that are available to win in “Koi Kash” and the odds of winning same.
- 2) The determination of whether or not a Player has won a Prize (and the level of any such Prize) is randomly determined by the Central Gaming System at the point of purchase of the Play.
- 3) Game sounds, animation and Player interfaces are solely for entertainment purposes and do not impact on the outcome of the Game.
