## The National Lottery

### Rules for Interactive Instant Win Game “Zap Out”

#### A. GENERAL

- 1) These are the Interactive Instant Win Game Specific Rules for the Game called “Zap Out” (hereinafter known as the “Specific Rules”) which will be operated by the National Lottery.
- 2) The General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games contain the general rules which apply to all Interactive Instant Win Games. For further information, please click [here](#). Additionally, both sets of rules can be obtained from Lottery Headquarters.
- 3) When you play “Zap Out”, these Specific Rules, the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, the Account Terms and the Data Privacy Statement apply. If there is any conflict or inconsistency between these Specific Rules and the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, these Specific Rules will prevail (unless the Company states otherwise).
- 4) The Game will commence on the date it is made available on the Interactive Channels and will remain available until such time as it is removed from the Interactive Channels. The Company reserves the right to recommence the Game at any time and for such duration as the Company decides at its sole discretion.
- 5) These Specific Rules have been approved by the Regulator in accordance with Section 45 of the Act.

- 8) Where the context so requires, in these Specific Rules, the neutral gender shall include the feminine or masculine gender and vice versa, the feminine gender shall include the masculine gender and vice-versa and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.
- 9) Capitalised words and expressions defined in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms but not herein shall have the same meanings as those set out in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms when used herein.

## B. COST OF PLAY

- 1) The price of a “Zap Out” play will be €3.

## C. HOW TO PLAY “ZAP OUT”

- 1) The Player chooses the “Zap Out” Game by clicking on the “Play” link on the Game Play Window. The opening screen below is then displayed.



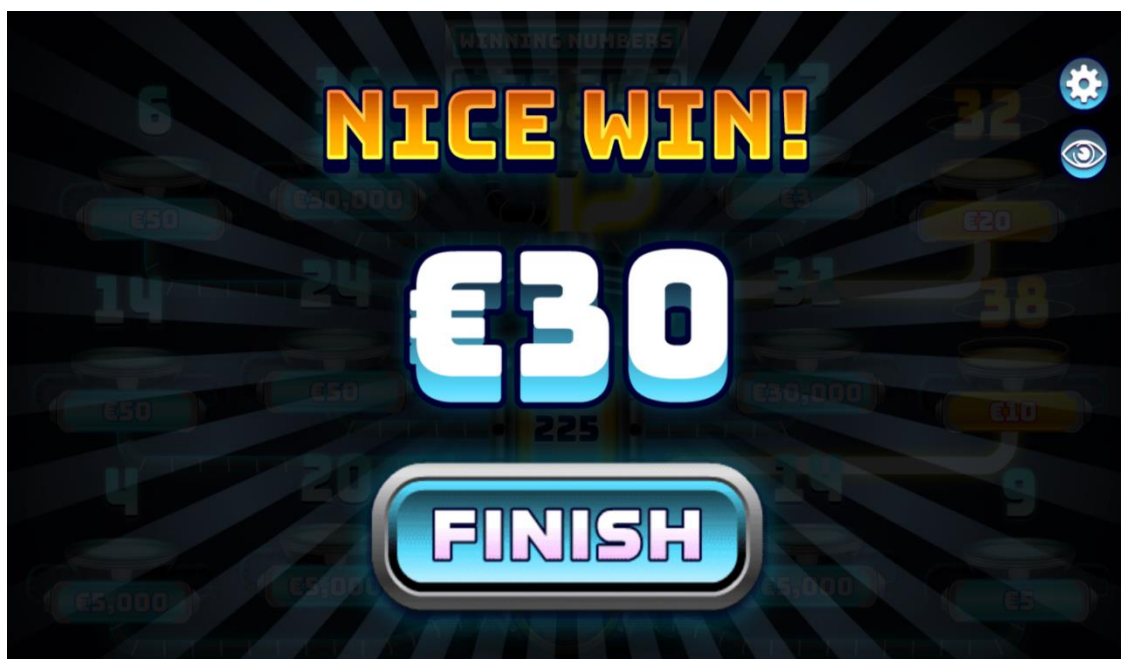
- 2) The Player clicks the arrow to continue. The Player is presented with a screen which shows twelve (12) play icons from which a number between 1 and 40 (inclusive) will be revealed, followed by a prize amount from the prize structure €3, €5, €10, €20, €50, €100, €500, €1,000, €5,000 and €30,000. A ‘WINNING NUMBERS’ panel which contains the three (3) unique ‘WINNING NUMBERS’ generated on game load. A “ZAP OUT” target panel which contains a target score generated on game load (target score will vary from game to game). The score target ranges from 150-250 inclusive (in increments of 25).



- 3) The aim of the Game is to match any of the revealed numbers to any of the 'WINNING NUMBERS' to win the Prize shown for that number.
- 4) The Player clicks the twelve (12) play icons to reveal a number between 1 and 40 inclusive and an associated prize amount. The value of all revealed numbers will be added to the "ZAP OUT NUMBER" score counter.
- 5) Once all 12 play icons have been revealed and if the target score is achieved or exceeded, any unmatched 'WINNING NUMBERS' will be replaced with new numbers to match against.



- 6) Once the Player has played, a message indicating the result will appear:

- 7) The Player is required to acknowledge this message by clicking the “FINISH” button.
- 8) The Game then ends, and the Player is presented with a screen confirming the outcome.

#### E. PRIZE AMOUNTS, NUMBER OF PRIZES AND ODDS OF WINNING VARIOUS PRIZES

- 1) The prize table that is set out below provides details on the Prizes that are available to win in “Zap Out” and the odds of winning same.
- 2) The determination of whether or not a Player has won a Prize (and the level of any such Prize) is randomly determined by the Central Gaming System at the point of purchase of the Play.
- 3) Game sounds, animation and Player interfaces are solely for entertainment purposes and do not impact on the outcome of the Game.
