The National Lottery

Rules for Scratch Card Game "Lucky 3s"

A. GENERAL

- 1) These are the Scratch Card Game Specific Rules for the Game called "Lucky 3s" (hereinafter known as the "**Specific Rules**") which will be operated by the National Lottery.
- 2) The Scratch Card Game General Rules contain the general rules which apply to all Scratch Card Games. For further information, please click here. Additionally, both sets of rules can be obtained from Lottery Headquarters.
- 3) When you play "Lucky 3s", these Specific Rules and the Scratch Card Game General Rules apply. If there is any conflict or inconsistency between these Specific Rules and the Scratch Card Game General Rules these Specific Rules will prevail (unless the Company states otherwise).
- 4) The Game will commence on a date to be announced and will continue until the Game End Date.
- 5) These Specific Rules have been approved by the Regulator in accordance with Section 45 of the Act.

- 8) Where the context so requires, in these Specific Rules, the neutral gender shall include the feminine or masculine gender and vice versa, the feminine gender shall include the masculine gender and vice-versa and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.
- 9) Capitalised words and expressions defined in the Scratch Card Game General Rules but not herein shall have the same meanings as those set out in the Scratch Card Game General Rules when used herein.

B. DEFINITIONS

The following words and terms will have the following meanings unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

1) Instant Prize means:

Game 1

The prize that is won when a Player reveals three symbols in any row, column or diagonal line in Game 1 in the Play Area of a Ticket.

Game 2


The prize that is won when a Player matches the LUCKY SYMBOL to any of YOUR SYMBOLS in Game 2 in the Play Area of a Ticket.

Game 3

The prize that is won when a Player matches three cash amounts in Game 3 in the Play Area of a Ticket.

2) **Play Symbols** mean the cash amounts or symbols which appear in the Play Area, along with their matching captions. These cash amounts, symbols, and captions will be derived from the following sets:

Game 1 Play Symbols



3) **Prize Percentage** means the total value of all Instant Prizes that are available to win in the Game as a percentage of the value of all Tickets in the Game.

C. COST OF PLAY

The price of a "Lucky 3s" Ticket will be €3.

D. HOW TO PLAY "LUCKY 3S"

1) The owner of a Ticket containing three Play Symbols in any one row, column or diagonal line in the Game 1 Play Area of a Ticket shall be entitled

- to the Instant Prize shown in the PRIZE box. The owner of a Ticket may win one Instant Prize in Game 1 on an individual "Lucky 3s" Ticket.
- 2) The owner of a Ticket who matches the LUCKY SYMBOL to any of YOUR SYMBOLS in the Game 2 Play Area of a Ticket shall be entitled to the Instant Prize amount shown for that symbol. The owner of a Ticket may win up to three Instant Prizes in Game 2 on an individual "Lucky 3s" Ticket.
- 3) The owner of a Ticket who matches three cash amounts in the Game 3 Play Area of a Ticket shall be entitled to an Instant Prize of the matched cash amount shown for that game. The owner of a Ticket may win one Instant Prize in Game 3 on an individual "Lucky 3s" Ticket.
- 4) The owner of a winning Ticket can win up to a maximum of five times on a "Lucky 3s" Ticket.

E. TICKET VALIDATION

- To be a valid "Lucky 3s" National Lottery Ticket in addition to the general conditions on Ticket validation set out in the Scratch Card Game General Rules (click here) the following specific conditions must be met:
- 2) Exactly ten Play Symbols and their matching captions must appear in the Game 1 Play Area.
- 3) Exactly eleven Play Symbols and their matching captions must appear in the Game 2 Play Area.
- 4) Exactly eight Play Symbols and their matching captions must appear in the Game 3 Play Area.
- 5) Each of the Play Symbols and their matching captions must be present in their entirety, must be fully legible and must be printed in grey/black ink;
- 6) Each of the Play Symbols and its captions appearing on the Ticket must be printed in accordance with the official font schedule for "Lucky 3s" as agreed between the Company and the Ticket manufacturer;
- 7) The Validation/Security Number must be printed in accordance with the official font schedule for "Lucky 3s" as agreed between the Company and the Ticket manufacturer;
- 8) The Game/Book/Ticket Number must be printed in accordance with the official font schedule for "Lucky 3s" as agreed between the Company and the Ticket manufacturer.

F. HOW TO CLAIM PRIZES

- 2) Instant Prizes must be claimed within 90 days of the Game End Date.

G. PRIZE AMOUNTS, NUMBER OF PRIZES AND ODDS OF WINNING VARIOUS PRIZES

- 1) The prize table that is set out below provides details on the Instant Prizes that are available to win in "Lucky 3s" and the odds of winning an Instant Prize.
- 2) At time of purchase some Instant Prizes may have already been won.
- 3) The figures below are based on a complete sale of all Tickets in the game. The Company may, at its discretion, extend the scale of a game by putting on sale a full reprint of the game or a larger or smaller version in direct proportion to the structure set out in the table below:
